


Your SIP is written...Now what?





Why Monitor the SIP?



- To ensure key activities are being implemented in a timely fashion.
- To assess the support and professional learning that educators need.
- To review data and evidence to know if efforts are impacting student learning.
- To adjust course when needed.



Establish a Protocol for Monitoring

Prepare for the meeting

Review relevant data and evidence

Determine next steps

Reassess the action plan





- Select at least one key activity
- Members reflect individually



Review and discuss

- Relevant data
- Evidence of implementation



Determine next steps

- Sustainable efforts
- Progressing efforts



Reassess activities that have not been started

- Determine why
- Keep or eliminate activity



Schedule sufficient time to monitor



- Establish a cadence to ensures all key activities are monitored multiple times over the school year.
- Plan ahead and come prepared to engage.
- Protect time for all involved in monitoring
