Purpose

To provide feedback to ISBE on necessary revisions to the secondary CTE PQR IWAS application. Will ensure programs of study meet the minimum [size, scope, and quality](#) definitions as required by the Strengthening Career and Technical Education for the 21st Century Act (Perkins V) and outlined in [Illinois' State Plan for Perkins V \(FY 2021-2024\)](#).



Timeline

- The initial pilot, including training, will run from 11/19/20 through 4/30/21
- Anticipate a second pilot using this platform in FY 2022

Benefits

Pilot Benefits and Expectations

- Early access to the required CTE PQR process; will not have to submit completed program reviews in the IWAS application until the next 4-year review cycle (FY 2025-2028)
- Utilize PQR data to increase communication with students and parents about the benefits of your CTE programs, potentially increasing enrollment and interest in programs
- Provide valuable feedback to ISBE to improve the platform and review process
- Increase collaboration opportunities with business and industry, as well as postsecondary education
- Highlight best practices in your CTE programs locally and statewide



Expectations

Pilot Benefits and Expectations

- Attain administrative approval to participate in the pilot
- Determine a lead school district, area career center (ACC), or regional program staff member or point of contact for the pilot
- Submit the pilot participation application by 12/18/20 – [Click here for the Pilot Application](#)
- Identify a team of staff members from the school district, ACC, or regional program to complete the pilot



Expectations

Pilot Benefits and Expectations

- Mandatory participation of a minimum of one pilot team member in:
 - An introductory webinar training in November 2020 AND
 - A mid-point check-in occurring in January 2021
- Complete the CTE program reviews in the online format for at least 5 programs or all programs if fewer than 5
 - Review the program of study by the [10 quality components](#)
 - Utilize FY 2020 Program Data Review (PDR) statistics provided by ISBE to focus on programs with the most need for quality improvement

- Complete an end-of-pilot survey collecting the following data points (*see CTE PQR End-of-Survey for feedback collection*):
 - Hours to complete individual program reviews
 - Identification of the number and role of staff members on your team
 - Description of business/industry and postsecondary education support
 - Recommendation for the best time of the year for completion
 - Reflection on barriers to completion
 - Reflection on successes
 - Any additional data points identified by the mid-point check-in
 - Additional data points the pilot participants feel are valuable for future program review teams
