Dear School or District Administrator:

ISBE is thrilled to announce an opportunity this school year for all public schools and districts to access the PSAT exams in grades 9 and 10 for their students. We believe this opportunity will further increase equitable access to the PSAT exam. ISBE was able to reduce the anticipated costs of some of its other accountability assessments for this year. As a result, ISBE is able to reimburse any public school, district, or serving educational entity for **one administration per student** of PSAT 8/9 – 9th Grade, PSAT/NMSQT - 10th Grade or PSAT 10 in **grades 9 and 10** for the **2017-18 school year only**. This reimbursement is available only for **existing<sup>1</sup> fall 2017** administrations and **existing or new spring 2018** administrations.

ISBE will reimburse any school or district that had already committed to a fall administration and will reimburse any school that had committed to or wants to add a spring administration. Schools or districts that had planned both fall and spring administrations will be reimbursed for one of those administrations.

The attached PSAT Master Eligibility List includes the districts and schools that are eligible for reimbursement. The list is also available on the ISBE Assessment website at <a href="https://www.isbe.net/Pages/PSATReimbursement.aspx">https://www.isbe.net/Pages/PSATReimbursement.aspx</a>. If you do not see your district, school, or educational entity on this list and believe you would be eligible, please email the Assessment Division at <a href="massessment@isbe.net">assessment@isbe.net</a>, subject line PSAT Reimbursement Eligibility. Include your entity name, RCDTS code, and the reason you believe you would be eligible for reimbursement.

All orders must be placed directly with the College Board. Instructions for placing an order are available on the ISBE <u>PSAT Reimbursement page</u>. A district price will be determined based on:

 The state discounted price of \$9 for PSAT 8/9-9th Grade and \$14.40 for PSAT/NMSQT -10th Grade or PSAT 10;

OR

 A district-specific price made in an agreement directly with the College Board.

College Board will provide an itemized invoice to the district or school, which districts will then submit to ISBE for reimbursement. Specific information on the reimbursement process will be posted as soon as it is available to the ISBE <u>PSAT Reimbursement page</u>.
