# Potential and Approved Professional Development Provider Guidance



## Are You Interested in Becoming an Illinois Approved Professional Development Provider?

An organization/entity interested in providing professional development must take the steps listed below to be put on the list of <u>Illinois Approved Professional Development Providers</u>.

- 1. Apply to be an approved professional development provider by completing the <u>Application for State Professional Development Provider</u>.
- 2. Once you have become an approved provider, you will need to complete the <u>Professional Development Provider Registration</u> form. Completing the provider registration form will allow your entity to appear on the drop-down list of approved providers in ELIS and PD+ that educators will see when entering their professional development toward license renewal.

## Who is Eligible to Apply to Become an Illinois Approved PD Provider?

# Entities Eligible to Apply to Become an Approved Provider • Illinois nonprofit organizations • Professional educator associations representing one or more of the following groups: School administrators, principals, school business officials, teachers (including special education teachers), school boards, school districts, parents, school support services personnel Entities Not Eligible to Become an Approved Provider • For-profit organizations • Out-of-state entities (including out-of-state institutions of higher education) • National organizations



### **Illinois Statutorily Approved Professional Development Providers**

(These providers must register annually, but do not need to apply for approval.)

- Regional Offices of Education and Intermediate Service Centers
- Illinois institutions of higher education that offer Illinois-approved educator preparation programs
- Illinois community and city colleges
- Illinois public schools and public-school districts
- Illinois charter schools
- Illinois joint career and technical education programs
- Illinois joint special education programs
- Illinois museums included in Section 10 of the Illinois Museum Disposition of Property Act
- Illinois state agencies, boards, and commissions
- Illinois Resource Center

## **Annual Renewal of Professional Development Provider's Registration**

Approved providers are required to renew their registration annually between April 1 and June 30 with the Illinois State Board of Education prior to offering any professional development activities in the current fiscal year. Providers will renew their registration through their PD+ accounts to complete this process. Please see the PD+ Access Guide for Provider Renewal.
