Summative Designations

- Accountability for the 2020-21 school year was waived; therefore, summative designations will *not* be calculated for 2021. Schools that have been previously identified for support will maintain that support status, but *no* 2021 annual summative designation will be reported. Instead the following message will be displayed on the Report Card:

 Summative Designations: 2021 Not Calculated
- The requirement to issue a summative designation was <u>waived</u> for school year 2020-21 so that data can be used to provide information to support reengagement and restoration. Local context is critical to understanding all reported data. Use caution when interpreting.
- The updated <u>2021 Official Summative Designation Business Rules</u> are now available on ISBE's website.
