Program Specifications

- RSSP students who are 16 years old or older
- Classroom instruction and supervision time
 - 200 minutes per week for a full year
- Work-place experience Fair Labor Standards Act
 - U.S. Department of Labor Fact Sheet #43
 - Occupations banned for minors under the age of 18
 - http://www.dol.gov/whd/regs/compliance/whdfs43.htm
- Upon successful completion of classroom instruction and work experience
 - Student receives high school credit for both school-related instruction and on-the-job experience

Eligible Applicants

Regional Safe Schools Programs (RSSP) that serve expulsion-eligible and multiple suspended students who are 16 years of age or older prior to the time of employment under the program. This program is currently established by 105 ILCS 5/13A of the Illinois School Code.

Licensure

 - Endorsement in Agriculture Education, Business, Marketing, and Computer Education, Family and Consumer Science, Health Science Technology, or Technology Education
- Educator License with Stipulations (ELS(CTE)/ELS(CTEP)
 - Endorsement in Agriculture Education, Business, Marketing, and Computer Education, Family and Consumer Science, Health Science Technology, or Technology Education
 - 60 credit hours of post-secondary education
 - Occupational Experience
 - 2,000 hours of related work experience outside of education
- Occupational study/course related to cooperative education
 - Six (6) hours in organizing and administering cooperative education

Teacher-Coordinator Responsibilities

- Course credit
 - Minimum 200 minutes per week
- IOEP plan for each student
- Partnership with employer and program
- Work experience
 - Minimum 10 hours per week
- Grades
- Approve and visit training sites
- Maintain adequate records
- Progress report

Program Requirements

- Work experience training
 - Award school credit
 - Relate to career opportunities advancement
 - Permissible employment student compensation
 - Does not displace other workers
 - Written training agreement
 - Between student and employer
 - Incorporates training plan
 - Worker verified tasks

Program Requirements

- Establish procedures/policies for:
 - Identifying suitable training sites
 - Attendance, changing or termination of employer, and holidays
 - Supporting training site policies and guidelines
 - Provide high school credit
 - Proof-of-age certificate or work permits
 - Teacher-coordinator travel reimbursement

- Timeliness for implementation
- Business provides appropriate work experience
