



Student Scores on the SAT Suite of Assessments







Individuals with this role can assign reporting roles to colleagues—and themselves—so they can get scores in K-12 Assessment Reporting.




Summary Reports


Provide access to the Raw Data Files for Your Systems page in Downloads. This role does not provide access to any reports.









 - Students must attend high school or be enrolled in a home school in the United States.
 - There are no minimum GPA, test score, citizenship status, or family income requirements.

How do students enter the drawings?

- When students complete one or more qualifying steps on BigFuture, they'll be automatically entered into drawings for \$500 or \$40,000.
- Students whose families earn less than \$60,000 per year have extra chances at BigFuture scholarships and earn double the entries for every drawing.
- Students can opt out of monthly scholarship drawings at bigfuture.org/scholarships-opt-out.
