What is Summer EBT?

- Summer EBT is a federal nutrition program that provides a grocery benefit during the summer months to families with children eligible for free or reduced price school meals.
- The Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2023 (P.L 117-328) authorized this permanent, nationwide Program beginning in 2024.
- Summer EBT is designed to reduce childhood hunger.
- Illinois will participate in this nationwide permanent Summer EBT program.
- Eligible children will receive a one-time benefit of \$120 per summer on an EBT card to purchase food.

Summer EBT Data Collection of Eligible Student Data Summer 2025 (Based on SY24-25 Eligibility)

The Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2023 (P.L 117-328) (the Act) authorized a permanent, nationwide Summer Electronic Benefit Transfer (Summer EBT) Program beginning in 2024. Summer EBT is designed to reduce childhood hunger by providing families with a monthly grocery benefit to feed their students during the summer months when the students are not receiving meals at school.

This module will be used to collect eligible student data for Summer EBT, who are NOT otherwise reported to ISBE for eligible NSLP participating schools, both public and nonpublic. Once submitted, ISBE will provide data to the Illinois Department of Human Services for further processing and issuance of Summer EBT benefits. Please ensure that only students that meet the socioeconomic criteria for free and reduced-price meals benefits, including CEP approved schools, are included within this data set.


- Data for S-EBT for non-public school students will be captured in the Web-Based Illinois Nutrition System (WINS).
