IAR Correction and Scores

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- Grades 3 – 8 students are required to test IAR.
 - Grade-based ELA and MATH tests are assigned.
- 2022 IAR Test Windows were identified by school. If a school did not enter dates, the Testing Window was defaulted to 03/07/2022 – 04/22/2022.
- Students are included in the Assessment Enrollment Verification/Correction report when the date of their SIS enrollment falls within the start and end dates of their Home School's Testing Window.



Assessment Enrollment Verification Report

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- The Assessment Enrollment Verification Report uses SIS enrollments to determine who should have tested.
 - Verify local testing rosters against this report to ensure all students are included.
It will not be possible to add enrollments after July 31, 2022.
- Districts have until July 31, 2022, to ensure that all students that tested appear on the Assessment Enrollment Verification Report.
- If students are not appearing on the Assessment Enrollment Verification Report, check the following:
 - Student is enrolled in the correct Home and Serving
 - Student is enrolled with the correct Start and End dates
 - Student is enrolled in Grades 3-8
 - Student is marked as Alternate Assessment (DLM-AA) = No in the student's Program Indicators

IAR Correction and Scores

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- Run the Assessment Enrollment Verification Report starting May 9, 2022.
 - Enrollments cannot be added after July 31, 2022!
- Starting July 8, 2022, districts should:
 - Run IAR Assessment Correction report, ensure all data is accurate, and enter Reason for No Valid Test Attempt (RNVTA) for students who did not test.
 - Update via the Assessment Correction link.
 - Run IAR Assessment Score Report to check for missing scores and errors.
 - Resolve any unassigned scores on the Unassigned Test Results Screen.
 - Sort the report by "Error" and resolve any issues.

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IAR Correction and Scores

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- Testing School and Test Code from the Pearson Score File will override the correction.
- If the Test Code of the Test Taken is inconsistent with the student's grade (Test to be Taken), error code 2 will appear on the IAR Score report. Resolve this error by updating the grade to match the Test Code grade or contact ISBE to suppress the data if the student took the test for the wrong grade level.
- For Private School Students who did not test (PSS=Yes in SIS), districts must enter RNVTA 16 to indicate that they didn't test due to not receiving instruction in ELA and/or Math from the public school. This is new in spring 2022.
