ACCESS Correction March 11 - August 25, 2024



ISBE will open the ACCESS Correction process on March 11, 2024.

- Demographic, Home School, and Grade details must reflect a student's status as of the last day of the ACCESS testing period.
- Changes made to the ACCESS correction data only affect the ACCESS Correction data; they do <u>not</u> update the student demographics information in SIS.
 - Updates to SIS student demographic, enrollment, and program indicator data (and enrollment exits)
 must also continue through the end of the school year.
 - If student demographic errors are identified in the ACCESS Correction file, revisions must be made both via the ACCESS Correction file and within SIS (via the Student Demographic/Enrollment batch file or the available online areas).
- An ACCESS Correction record can only be added if the student has an EL record in your district for the 2023-24 school year.






ACCESS Assessment Correction – Details Report






Assessment Correction – ACCESS – Search by Student






ACCESS Assessment Correction Student – Demographics






ACCESS Assessment Correction – Indicators



- ISBE will send Student Pre-ID data updates weekly to KITE.
- ISBE sends last data update to the assessment vendor March 8, 2024
 - After March 15, 2024, do not upload students' data into KITE.
 - Instead, contact <a>Pam Hartwig for assistance.
 - DLM-AA Testing's Earliest Start Date: March 13, 2024
 - DLM-AA Testing's Latest End Date: May 8, 2024
 - First day of the DLM-AA Correction in SIS: TBD

Creation of DLM-AA Pre-ID for Grades 3-11*:


- Students testing DLM-AA must be IDEA Services (IEP) = Yes.
- A DLM-AA Pre-ID record will be created for all students Grades 3-11* who have DLM-AA record as their most recent assessment in SIS and are currently IDEA Services (IEP) = Yes.
 - *Current Grade 12 students without a valid Grade 11 or 12 score or qualifying exemption from any previous Grade 11 or 12 DLM-AA administration will be rostered to take DLM-AA in spring 2024 in ELA and Mathematics.
- The test can be updated to DLM-AA by selecting Alternate Assessment: DLM-AA Yes/No (Grades 3-12) on the **Program Indicators** page in SIS.
- The test can also be updated through the **Student Demographics and Enrollment file format (Batch)**, with Alternate Assessment Indicator set to 01 (Yes) or 02 (No).
- DLM-AA students in Grades 3-12 may participate in the optional, instructionally embedded assessments. SIS will load only Grades 3-11, and Grade 12 as required. Contact Pam Hartwig for assistance with Grade 12 students or with instructionally embedded assessments.








Assessment – Pre-ID – DLM-AA – search by student.









Data Collection Practices for IAR Pre-ID

- Enroll students in Grades 3-8, verify Alternate Assessment is set to "No" on the Program Indicators page, and Update Testing RCDTS if it differs from Serving RCDTS.
- All accommodations and accessibility features are entered directly into PearsonAccess^{Next} (PAN).
- December 19, 2023: SIS sent the first IAR data transmission to PAN
- Districts can send Pre-ID updates to PAN as needed through SIS.
- On a weekly basis, ISBE will send updated IAR data to PAN.
- Districts should continue to review and update the IAR Pre-ID data in SIS.
- April 18, 2024: ISBE will upload the final Pre-ID to PAN




Pre-ID for Grades 3-8:

- An IAR Pre-ID record for both ELA and Mathematics exists for all Grades 3-8 students unless the Alternate Assessment (DLM-AA) indicator in the SIS enrollment "Program Indicators" tab is set to "Yes."
 - Note that the "IDEA Services" indicator must be "Yes" to set the Alternate Assessment (DLM-AA) indicator to "Yes."
- Only Home and Serving School Districts can enter or update Testing RCDTS.







- When a student's enrollment is added, the student will be added on the appropriate Pre-ID report based on the enrollment grade Level and Alternate Assessment indicator.








- IAR Pre-ID transmission to PAN allows district/school staff to send enrollment updates/changes.
- Accommodations that are listed for a student in PAN will not move with the student records.
- This tool will assist district/school staff with enrollment changes and create permanent student records in PAN at the new district/school.
- **IMPORTANT:** The "IAR Summative" button is used to send the IAR student roster to the Assessment vendor PAN. A school or a district can select the "IAR Summative" button when enrolling students for the first time or if the student changes to a new school within the same district. Districts may send the data as often as needed. Any accommodations that were loaded separately into PAN by the previous school WILL BE REMOVED. This occurs because the data transfer process completely deletes a student from PAN and re-enrolls the student into PAN.
 - Always double check accommodations in PAN for students new to your school.



- ISA Pre-ID records will be created for all Grades 5, 8, and 11 students who do not have Alternate Assessment (DLM-AA) 'Yes' on the Program Indicators page.
- ISA testing location will be set based on IAR (Grades 5 and 8) and SAT (Grade 11) data in SIS.
- All accommodations and accessibility features are entered directly into PearsonAccess^{Next} (PAN).
- December 19, 2023: SIS sent the first ISA data transmission to PAN
- Districts can send Pre-ID updates to PAN as needed through SIS.
- On a weekly basis, ISBE will send updated ISA data to PAN.
- Districts should continue to review and update the ISA Pre-ID data in SIS.
- April 18, 2024: ISBE will upload the final Pre-ID to PAN
- Visit the <u>ISBE ISA webpage</u> for test administration details.




ISA Testing Window:

- March 4, 2024 (earliest) April 30, 2024 (latest)
 - Note: ISBE will collect school-level test windows by district level users via IAR data.
 - Grades 5, 8, and 11 students for whom DLM-AA is the more appropriate assessment will continue to participate in the DLM-AA science assessment in lieu of the ISA.
- ISA will be administered in an online format and is aligned to the Illinois Learning Standards for Science incorporating the Next Generation Science Standards, which were adopted in 2014.







SAT with Essay, PSAT 10, and PSAT 8/9 Pre-ID

- <u>IMPORTANT</u>: With the shift from paper to digital testing in spring 2024, it is critical that districts continue to review and keep SIS enrollments up to date.
 - Friday, February 2, 2024: SAT with Essay, PSAT 10, and PSAT 8/9 Pre-ID data in SIS were initially transmitted to College Board.
 - Every Friday, ISBE will transmit updated PSAT/SAT Pre-ID data to College Board.
 - Friday, April 19, 2024: ISBE's final transmission of Pre-ID data to College Board.
 - All students enrolled in SIS in Grades 9, 10, and 11 are assigned to take PSAT 8/9, PSAT 10, or SAT with Essay (per grade level, respectively) unless DLM-AA is identified as the appropriate state assessment.
 - SAT with Essay will also be administered to some Grade 12 students, as described in this <u>flow</u> chart.
 - If a student will take DLM-AA instead, adjust the alternate assessment indicator in the "Program Indicators" tab in the SIS enrollment.



Student Attendance Deadline: July 12, 2024



- Using the student enrollment Percent of Day on Enrollment (PDA), ISBE will do the calculation for final reporting purposes.
- Report student attendance for regular school year enrollments ONLY.
- Summer school and ESY attendance should not be reported.
- Attendance data is not accepted for an enrollment that was exited erroneously.
- Attendance data is optional for private school students.
- July 12, 2024: Attendance data is due



- In Average Daily Attendance (ADA) reports, ISBE uses the PDA to determine the percent of day for each of the Attendance Types.
- Districts should report 1.000 Absence for a full day missed and 0.500 Absence for a half-day missed.
- If the student is enrolled with a PDA of 0.50 and the district reports 0.500 in the Total Days Present, ISBE will calculate that the student was present for a quarter of the day.

- Enrollment Date: The begin date of enrollment is the first day the school expected the student to attend.
 - If the student did not attend on the expected day due to an excused absence, the student should be enrolled on the expected date and the student is marked absent. Do not submit an enrollment record until the student has attended at least one day.


- Exit Date: The last day of enrollment is the last day the student attended school.
 - If the student transfers to another district and delays before enrolling, the missed school days are not recorded at either school unless the school has knowledge of the situation and knows the student is absent from their school. In any event if the student enrolls at a new school, the prior school's enrollment should be exited on the day prior to enrolling in the new school. If a student attends a portion of the day at the old school, the new school cannot begin the enrollment until the next day.




Detention Center

- There are 22 Illinois detention centers associated with 21 districts.
- The district in which the detention center is located is responsible for submitting the detention center records.
 - The detention center (or the district in which it is located) is responsible for entering and exiting the record when the student leaves the detention center.
