Child Nutrition Program Emergency Operating Costs During COVID-19: Implementation Guidance



USDA Meal Programs

- CNP- Child Nutrition Program includes Child and Adult Food Care Program (CACFP), Summer Food Service Program (SFSP), School Nutrition Programs (SNP)
- SNP-School Nutrition Program includes National School Lunch Program (NSLP), School Breakfast Program (SBP), Afterschool Snack, Seamless Summer Option (SSO)



ISBE responsibility

- Identify eligible sponsors
- Calculate reimbursements
- Disperse funds to sponsors

SNP Sponsor Responsibility

- Use reimbursement funds for allowable program expenses
- Provide ISBE with an Assurance Statement, if requested



ISBE- Identify Eligible Sponsors

Sponsor must Operate/Claim:

- National SchoolLunch Program or
- School BreakfastProgram or
- Afterschool SnackProgram or
- Summer Food
 Service Program

 Operate during either-SY 2018-2019 in March-June or January 2020 and/or February 2020

And

 Claim meals under a Child Nutrition Program (NSLP, SBP/Snack/SFSP)
 September- December 2020 or later



ISBE- Identify Eligible Sponsors

Sponsor must Operate/Claim:

- National School
 Lunch Program or
- School BreakfastProgram or
- Afterschool SnackProgram or
- Summer Food
 Service Program

 Operate during either-SY 2018-2019 in March-June or January 2020 and/or February 2020

And

 If no Child Nutrition Program was operated in Program Year 2021, sponsors will need to provide ISBE an Assurance Statement, agreeing to provide and claim meals at the end of the public health emergency



ISBE-Calculate Reimbursement Funds

March for Existing Sponsors

- March 2019 Reimbursement minus
- March 2020 Reimbursement,
- Multiply by 55% and
- Divide totally by 2
- Equals reimbursement funds for March 2020

Sample- March Existing SNP Sponsor

Existing SNP Sponsor (operated NSLP SY2018-2019)

Calculate March Emergency Cost Funds

March 2019 minus March 2020= difference

Difference multiply by 55%= March total amount

March total amount divide by 2= March total Payment

March 2019 \$30,000.00

March 2020 -\$21,000.00

\$9,000.00

\$9,000.00 × .55= \$4,950.00

\$4,950.00 ÷ 2= \$2,375.00

\$2,375.00 March total payment



ISBE-Calculate Reimbursement Funds

April-June

- Claim month (April/May/June)2019 minus
- Claim month (April/May/June)2020,
- multiply by 55%
- Equal total reimbursement (April/May/June)



Sample-April-June SNP Calculation

Existing SNP Sponsor (operated NSLP SY2018-2019)

Calculation method for: April, May and June Emergency Cost Funds

April 2019 minus April 2020= difference Difference multiply by 55%= April total payment

April 2019 \$35,000.00

April 2020 <u>-\$20,000.00</u>

\$15,000.00

\$15,000.00 × .55= \$8,250.00

\$8,250.00 April total payment



Sample-April-June SNP Calculation

Existing SNP Sponsor (operated NSLP SY2018-2019)

April 2019 minus April 2020= difference

April total payment zero if 2020 is greater than 2019

April 2019 \$19,000.00

April 2020 -\$20,000.00

- \$1,000.00

April total payment = \$0



ISBE-Disburse Funds to Sponsors

- ISBE Funding and Disbursement Department will distribute funds according to calculation formula
- Funds will be sent through WINS/FRIS and automatically deposited in sponsor's account
- Sponsors do not need to calculate or request funds
- Funds will be disbursed by January 31, 2022.



Sponsor Responsibilities-

- Use Funds:
 - Allowable program expenses
 - Reimburse local source funds used to supplement and maintain documentation.
- Assurance statement-only sponsors that have not resumed operations must return statements when requested
