Designation of the State Seal of Biliteracy and the State Commendation toward Biliteracy

In accordance with Section 2-3.159 of the School Code, participating school districts must place a designation of a qualifying student's receipt of the State Seal of Biliteracy in the student's permanent record on the academic transcript as defined in 23 III. Adm. Code 375 (Student Records) and include the designation on the student's diploma. School districts that choose to award the State Commendation toward Biliteracy must also place a designation of a qualifying student's receipt of the award both in the permanent record on the academic transcript and on the student's diploma.

The district <u>must</u> include the following designations on a qualifying student's diploma and transcript:

Diploma The designation must be printed on the diploma or affixed to the diploma. Transcript The statement with the name of the foreign language inserted must appear on the student's transcript. Students who qualify for the Seal of Biliteracy or Commendation toward Biliteracy prior to graduation and issuance of their final transcript may have the following statement included on their transcript:

"Provisionally awarded the Seal of Biliteracy in [language(s)] contingent upon graduation."
-or-

"Provisionally awarded the Commendation toward Biliteracy in [language(s)] contingent upon graduation."

Please be sure to update the statement upon student graduation.
