SUBJECT: Qualifying ACT score for the Illinois State Seal of Biliteracy

Per [Ill. Admin. Rule 680.20](#), students can demonstrate English proficiency for the State Seal of Biliteracy via “attainment of college and career benchmarks for English language arts on the State assessments administered at the secondary level.”

The Illinois State Board of Education advises districts participating in the State Seal of Biliteracy that the [ACT college readiness benchmark](#) for the ELA portion of the exam is a 20. An ACT composite score of 21 also is acceptable.
