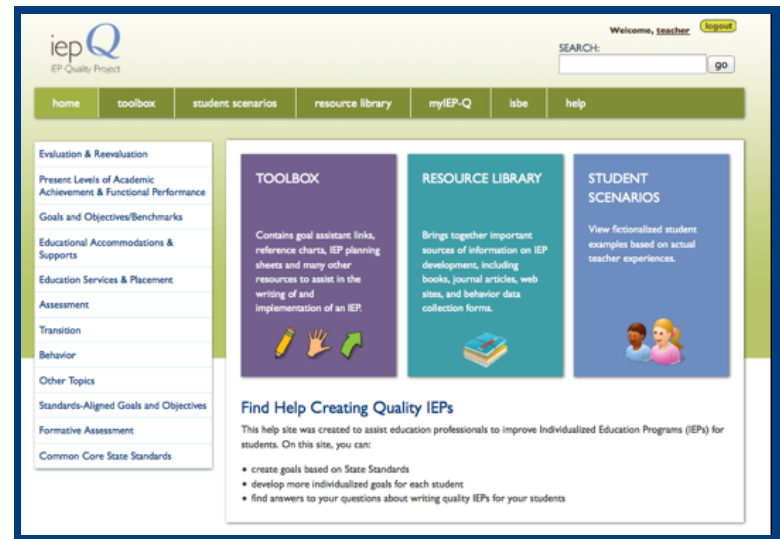


The IEP Quality Tutorial can help you...
