# ISBE Strategic Plan

2022-2023 Annual Status Report





#### Introduction

As required in 105 ILCS 5/2-3.47a, the State Board of Education shall develop and maintain a continuing comprehensive strategic plan for elementary and secondary education. The 2020-2023 Strategic Plan was approved by the State Board of Education on November 19, 2020. The plan consists of goals for equity, student learning, learning conditions, and elevating educators. The plan acknowledges that every district contains unique assets and requires different approaches to support and develop these assets.

The Strategic Plan leverages the wide range of talents and interests of ISBE staff, practicing educators, and stakeholders and considers how best to support agency work during and in the wake of the COVID-19 pandemic.

This report provides an update on the status of the 2020-2023 Strategic Plan, including:

- 1. Highlights of from the work of the strategic plan during 2023;
- 2. Information on the extension of 2020-2023 Strategic Plan through FY 2024 while the 2025-2030 Strategic Plan is in development; and
- 3. The process for the creation of the 2025-2030 Strategic Plan.

The goals identified in the 2020-2023 ISBE Strategic Plan are:

- **Equity Goal (Internal)** An equity impact analysis tool will guide all decisions and communications provided to the field.
- **Equity Goal (External)** An Equity Journey Continuum will be used to publicly indicate where each Illinois school district is on its equity journey.
- **Goal 1: Student Learning** Every child will make significant academic gains each year, increasing their knowledge, skills, and opportunities so they graduate equipped to pursue a successful future, with the state paying special attention to addressing historic inequities.
- **Goal 2: Learning Conditions** All districts and schools will receive the resources necessary to create safe, healthy, and welcoming learning environments, and will be equipped to meet the unique academic and social and emotional needs of each and every student.
- **Goal 3: Elevating Educators** Illinois' diverse student population will have educators who are prepared through multiple pathways and are supported in and celebrated for their efforts to provide each and every child an education that meets their needs.

### Extension of 2020-2023 Strategic Plan

The current Strategic Plan concludes on June 30, 2023; however, ISBE will extend the plan through FY 2024. ISBE shall submit a report to the Governor and General Assembly prior to July 1, 2024, with any updates to the plan as well as early progress in achieving its goals. The extension of the 2020-2023 Strategic Plan, which aligns with the requirements in statute, includes, but is not limited to, the continuation of:

- Equity Goal (External) The public-facing Equity Journey Continuum for all school districts;
- **Goal 1, Strategy 1.1 -** Professional learning for educators focused on alignment of district-approved curricula to the Illinois Learning Standards;
- **Goal 2, Strategy 2.1.5** Curation of resources and updated reporting materials that endeavor to improve equitable and strategic resource allocation occurring in schools;
- **Goal 2, Strategy 2.2.1** The availability of SEL Hubs across Illinois to enhance student mental health and well-being;
- **Goal 2, Strategy 2.1.4** Learning opportunities and targeted supports to address and reduce implicit bias in school and district practices;
- Goal 3, Strategy 3.1 Providing institutions of higher education with approved teacher preparation programs support from content experts as they develop their diverse educator recruitment and retention plans; and
- **Goal 3, Strategy 3.3** Grant programs supporting educators in obtaining the English Learner/bilingual endorsement, supporting the retention of special education teachers, and supporting other teacher pipeline objectives.

#### 2025-2030 Strategic Plan

The Illinois State Board of Education hired Dr. Tony Sanders, previously the superintendent of Elginarea School District U-46, as the state superintendent effective February 23, 2023. Upon his arrival, Dr. Sanders began a 90-day listening and learning tour across Illinois, including meetings with practitioners, stakeholders, and ISBE staff. The listening tour will inform the development of priorities and a vision for ISBE for future years. Dr. Sanders will lead the development of the 2025-2030 Strategic Plan, working with the Board, ISBE staff, and stakeholders during the remainder of 2023.
