Schedule

- Have you planned with the student's other teachers to ensure students do not have multiple big projects due at the same time?
- Have you planned with the student's other teachers to ensure equitable amount of time spent nightly on homework?
- Are there any special events or activities in the evening that students are required or asked to attend?
- Are there any holidays that would prevent students from completing the homework in a timely manner?
- Will I be able to grade/provide feedback promptly?



Quality

- Will completing this assignment help the student practice a lacking skill or deepen their understanding of the concept?
- Is this assignment/project something the student can complete without adult assistance?
- Does effort match the weight of the grade?
- Have you you planned with teachers in your school/ district teaching the same grade and subject to ensure consistency and equity?
- Have you checked for any implicit bias or added accommodations for different student groups?
- Have you considered student/family input?
