Assessment Security Monitoring Survey

The Federal Peer Review process Critical Element 2: Assessment Systems Operation requires states to monitor test administration procedures for all State Accountability Assessments (SAAs). To ensure a fair and accurate administration and the security of SAAs and their test items, all educational and support staff who handle test materials are expected to read, understand and comply with the Test Security documents produced and distributed by ISBE for the various assessment programs. This survey collects information at the district level regarding training procedures and an affirmation from the superintendent (or designee) to comply with the information contained in the Test Security Agreement below.





DLM Individual Score Reports

- Scheduled to be available in Kite on June 17, 2022.
- Students who are served outside of their home school will require a copy of the ISR be sent to the student's home district.



Corrections

- The Assessment Enrollment Verification Report became available in SIS on May 9, 2022.
- Have until July 31, 2022, to ensure all students that tested appear on the Assessment Enrollment Verification Report
- DLM-AA corrections will begin on July 8, 2022, when scores are scheduled to be posted in SIS.
- Last Day of Corrections for the Purpose of Accountability and School Report Card for SY 2022 due by Thursday, August 26, 2022.



Important!

- If students are not appearing on the Assessment Enrollment Verification Report, check the following:
 - Student is enrolled in the correct Home and Serving School
 - Student is enrolled with the correct Start and End dates
 - Student is marked as IDEA services = Yes in the student's Program Indicators
 - Student is marked as Alternate Assessment (DLM-AA) = Yes in the student's Program Indicators



User Accounts Recommendation

- Now through summer months, update user accounts if you didn't get a chance to do so prior to the Spring 2022 test window.
 - •Remove users and update any accounts with the "proctor" role. The proctor role should be removed and, if needed, replaced with "teacher".
- If a new district test coordinator needs to be added, superintendent should send an email with their request to <u>Pam Hartwig</u>


OnDemand Reports and Summative Data files are now available in PearsonAccess^{next} to those users with the roles of District or School Test Coordinator or with the Report Access role. These reports can be used for summer school and fall schedule planning.

OnDemand Reports

An OnDemand Report (ODR) score is provided for each student record that received a valid score. See additional OnDemand Report guidance.

You have the ability to manage the columns and create the report that you need. There is also the option to add the Lexile and Quantile results for each student.

SCORE REPORTING

District and School Summative Data Files

New for spring 2022, users can access a data file that contains all students registered and assigned a test in PearsonAccess^{next} for the IAR spring 2022 administration. The District Summative file contains students for all schools in a district and the School Summative file contains all students at that school. Records that have met "attemptedness" and are not voided will have scale scores and performance level information in the file.

The final Summative Data file will be available on July 1st.



CORRECTIONS

Districts and schools will need to download the <u>Assessment Enrollment Verification Report</u> to determine who should have tested during your testing window. You will need to verify that your enrollment records match your local testing roster and that all of the information for the students who tested is correct. Districts have until July 31, 2022, to ensure that all students that tested appear on the Assessment Enrollment Verification Report. <u>Enrollments will not be able to be added after this date.</u>

Please keep a record of the students who missed the assessment along with the reasons so that you can review and resolve all discrepancies in SIS during the corrections window, <u>July</u> <u>8th - August 26, 2022</u>.

During this time, you will be able to:

- Apply the appropriate RNVTA codes for missing scores.
- Review and match all "unassigned" test records.

ISA Corrections in IWAS

 The ISA corrections window for entering Reason for No Valid Test Attempt Codes (RNVTA) is open in IWAS under the Illinois Science Assessment tab from May 2 – June 19.

Reason for No Valid Test Attempt Document Link (RNVTA)

- Student testing data has updated from ISBE Teach to IWAS, showing ISA student test attempts vs no test attempts.
- District access to IWAS is granted by the district superintendent.
 If you are attempting to enter RNVTA codes and cannot access
 IWAS see your district superintendent.



ISA Duplicate Rostering


- If a student was added manually by a district, it will cause a duplicate 24-digit account for that student.
- A student might also have accounts at two different schools due to a student transfer.
- ISBE is in the process of merging and deleting those duplicate accounts.
- If you are seeing a student in your IWAS rostering that is requiring a RNVTA code but tested on one of the two enrollment records, ISBE will drop the student's unused record from rostering when the file updates.





Diploma Exemption Documents

Submit a diploma exemption only for a student who will be scheduled to receive a regular high school diploma before the next administration of the state's final accountability assessment (i.e., SAT or grade 11 DLM-AA) and hasn't tested or been identified in SIS as being exempt or for a student whose exemption was not identified through ISBE SIS programming according to the flowchart document. If your district believes there is evidence in SIS of an exemption, please write to assessment@isbe.net for verification before completing any of the diploma exemption paperwork.
