Assessment Security Monitoring Survey

The Federal Peer Review process Critical Element 2: Assessment Systems Operation requires states to monitor test administration procedures for all State Accountability Assessments (SAA).

To ensure a fair and accurate administration and the security of SAA's and their test items, all educational and support staff who handle test materials are expected to read, understand and comply with the Test Security documents produced and distributed by ISBE for the various assessment programs. This survey collects information at the district level regarding training procedures and an affirmation from the superintendent (or designee) to comply with the information contained in the Test Security Agreement.

Kindergarten Individual Development Survey

All Illinois School Districts...

...are now **beyond the mandated data entry date** (the 40th day of student attendance) for the FALL SY23 KIDS data collection.

The Fall SY23 Rating Period has ended and all district data entry windows in KIDStech are closed for FALL student ratings.





Student Exemption Process

In the next few weeks, ISBE will be releasing the KIDS Fall SY23 Student Exemption guidance, process, and documentation for:

• any students not rated, not fully rated, or

• with an "unable to rate" rating for one or more of the state-required 14 measures.





Student Exemption Process Cont.

As in past years, school districts will need to submit a KIDS Student Exemptions and Reason Code for **each student rated on FEWER than the 14 state-required measures**.

Please begin the process of gathering information on students that will need an exemption, along with documentation (if appropriate) to support your submitted exemption for each student.



KIDS Data Use

REMEMBER:

- The 14 State-Required measures provide populationbased information about the overall readiness of a group of children at the beginning of kindergarten. This subset of 14 measures provides a PROXY of GROUP-LEVEL readiness at the beginning of kindergarten.
- The 14 State-Required measures should NOT be used for school accountability, teacher evaluation or performance, or to determine student placement.







KIDS Data - Local Utility

Schools and districts ALWAYS have the option to collect more than current mandate of the 14 measures, once, at the beginning of kindergarten for state purposes:

- 14 ratings two or three times per year,
- Full developmental domains,
- Additional domains, such as ELD or SPAN for specific populations,
- 29 measures in the Five Domains of Readiness,
- 55 measures in the 11 Domains of Readiness.



Accessing Local KIDS Data

There are two sources for KIDS data:

- KIDStech: Immediate; Local; Raw Data (no "readiness" psychometrics)
 - Useful for: tailoring current district/school/class/student instruction, practice, curriculum
- ISBE Statewide Data/Reports: Typically released spring/summer AFTER fall data collection; district and state-level results; "readiness" psychometrics applied
 - Useful for: identifying areas for PD, potential differences in collection methods, areas for support, big picture info





KIDStech Data

- Based on access level (district admin/school admin/teacher), individuals can immediately acquire data through KIDStech.
 - Information available varies by number of measures collected;
 - At a minimum, KIDS Data:
 - Can identify general strengths and areas for additional support for a GROUP of students;
 - Can assist in identifying PD opportunities for teachers/administrators.








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Sample Parent Report (Full Domains)

The Approaches to Learning skills include attention maintenance, engagement and persistence, and curiosity and initiative. The Self-Regulation skills include self-comforting, self-control of feelings and behavior, imitation, and shared use of space and materials.

At the Building Middle level, your child often seeks adult support when facing challenges, such as managing feelings or when doing complex activities, and is learning how to observe, test, and ask specific questions about how things work. You can support learning and development by encouraging your child's natural sense of curiosity and asking questions such as "What would happen if?" when your child discovers a new idea. Be available to provide support when your child is trying to manage feelings such as anger or sadness or is doing a complex activity.

At the Integrating Earlier level, your child is learning how to work with familiar adults and other children to plan play and problem-solving activities, to discuss and decide on roles and rules for pretend play, and to communicate about how people's personalities affect their feelings and behaviors. You can support learning and development by helping your child generate ideas for solving problems encountered with materials during play, expressing enthusiasm for your child's new ideas, and encouraging your child to come up with and try different solutions. Submit a diploma exemption only for a student who will be scheduled to receive a regular high school diploma before the next administration of the state's final accountability assessment (i.e., SAT or grade 11 DLM-AA) and hasn't tested or been identified in SIS as being exempt <u>or</u> for a student whose exemption was not identified through ISBE SIS programming according to the <u>flowchart document</u>. If your district believes there is evidence in SIS of an exemption, please write to <u>assessment@isbe.net</u> for verification before completing any of the diploma exemption paperwork.

- All foreign exchange students who are classified as grade 11

PSAT 10

- All students enrolled in SIS as grade 10 at the time of testing unless rostered instead for DLM-AA
- All foreign exchange students who are classified as grade 10


PSAT 8/9

- All students enrolled in SIS as grade 9 at the time of testing unless rostered instead for DLM-AA
- All foreign exchange students who are classified as grade 9

Note: Students who are enrolled in SIS but are home-schooled or attend a private school (and not placed there by the public school) must test <u>only</u> if receiving instruction in ELA and/or math from the public school. Grade 12: Who Must Test?



Students who transfer into an Illinois public school for the first time (e.g., from out of state, from a private school, or who were home schooled) who have sufficient credits to qualify for grade 12 status do not and may not participate in SAT with Essay or DLM-AA in spring 2023, as they were not considered part of the Illinois public school system during grade 11.

*For situations not addressed by this flow chart (e.g., errors in SIS enrollment records, exit codes that may communicate an exemption) or if your district believes a grade 12 student is erroneously identified as being required or not required to participate in the SAT with Essay or DLM-AA in spring 2023, please contact the Department of Assessment for direction by calling 866-317-6034 or writing to <u>assessment@isbe.net</u>.





- The final list of established test sites for spring 2023 was posted November 3 on <u>www.isbe.net/Pages/sat-psat.aspx</u>.
- If the "Testing School" in the Pre-ID report is not on the list of established test sites, ISBE will be adjust it to match the "Home School" before the Pre-ID file is transmitted to College Board in January.
- SIS is now programmed to check for this issue and displays "E" for error on the Pre-ID detail report.

ASSESSMENT SAT WITH ESSAY, PSAT 10, PSAT 8/9

Beginning in spring 2017, ISBE began requiring all public-school students in grade 11 to take the SAT with Essay, unless the student takes the grade 11 DLM-AA instead. Additionally, some public-school students in grade 12 🌄 may also be required to take the SAT with Essay or DLM-AA, as appropriate.

Beginning in spring 2019, ISBE began assessing all public-school students in grade 9 with the PSAT 8/9 and all public-school students in grade 10 with the PSAT 10, unless the student takes the grade 9 or 10 DLM-AA instead.

- Students in grades 5, 8 and 11 will be assessed in Science
 - 12th graders will not be rostered for Science



Kite Portal Differences

- Kite Educator Portal Teachers and administrators (DTCs & BTCs) have accounts here. This is the application through which student data is entered and managed. Access to reports is provided here.
- Kite Student Portal Platform where the assessment is administered. Teachers and administrators do not have accounts. Students are logged in with a unique username and password.



Who Can Administer the DLM?

- For districts struggling with staffing issues, other employees besides a teacher can administer the DLM
 - Check out <u>this resource</u>
 - If a paraprofessional will be administering the DLM, they must be in constant-line-of sight supervision of a licensed educator
 - Licensed educator must input any student responses for teacheradministered testlets
- Before test administration can begin:
 - Ensure the test administrator has an active Kite Educator
 Portal account
 - Completed security agreement
 - Verify the test administrator has completed training



Which Essential Elements are Tested?

- DLM maintains a list of currently tested essential elements on its website
 - <u>ELA</u>
 - <u>Math</u>
 - <u>Science</u>
- Provides the nodes at each linkage level and a mini-map showing the pathways between the nodes
