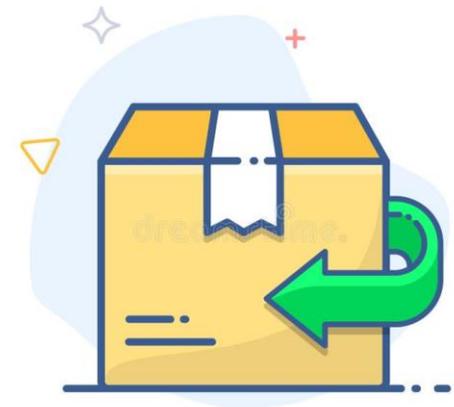

# 2026 ISA Practice Items

- Test-Nav practice items and The Student Readiness Tool are now available on the Pearson support page. [Test-Nav interaction practice items](#) help students become familiar with the several types of question interactions used on the Test Nav 8 platform.

[The Student Readiness Tool](#) allows students to practice interacting with the Test-Nav platform including moving from question to question, reviewing and bookmarking questions, and submitting test answers.

# QuISBE ISA Practice Exams

- QuISBE is a new practice exam platform for the ISA. It provides 5th and 8th grade students with practice-exams similar to the ISA summative assessment.
- The 30-item practice exams are approximately the same length as a single section of the ISA, so they are a good measure for how long your students may take to complete a single section of the exam.
- When using **TTS**, we suggest using the fast setting for grade 8 and the normal or fast setting for grade 5

# QuISBE - Practice Exam Platform

- To gain access to the QuISBE platform, you must first fill out the [QuISBE Participation SY2025-26 form](#) to register.
- Pearson will provide further access instructions after the participation form is submitted. This normally takes 24 hours.

Note: QuISBE is not the testing platform for the summative ISA exam

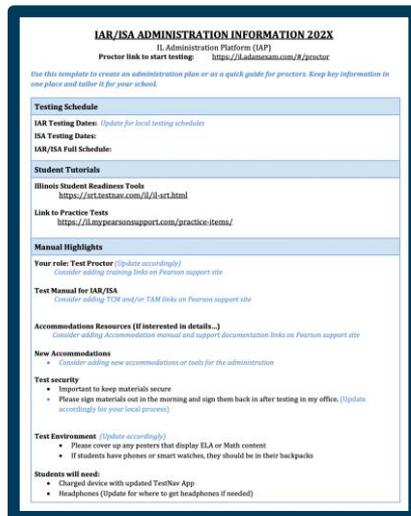

## IAR TEST MANAGEMENT RESOURCES

### [Creating Proctor Groups](#)

There are two main ways to manage proctor groups:

- Add students to proctor groups in advance of testing.
- Create empty proctor groups and have students sign into the proctor group on the morning of testing.

[ISBE's recommended approach to establishing proctor groups is to include students in proctor groups prior to testing. Establishing proctor groups in advance allows you to:](#)

- ✓ Organize groups to generate test codes based on content area and grade level.
  - ✓ Determine student seating arrangements according to Proctor Groups, which may be organized by homeroom, English teacher, small group, or other criteria as appropriate.
  - ✓ Enter relevant details for each Proctor Group, including the Test Proctor's name, grade, subject, and designated testing room.
  - ✓ Print student and proctor print cards for the campus.

## TEST MANAGEMENT

### Administration Cards

Both the home and serving school have the ability to access a student within the platform. Therefore, a school that was NOT selected to participate will see the Section 3 Administration Card housing their students for a serving school who WAS selected to participate in the field test.

You can check on the students in that group by clicking on the teal-colored bar to load the amount under that card or by clicking on the three dots to view the students and validate that they are tied to multiple organizations and that one of these other schools was most likely selected to participate in the field test.

If you are the home school and you were not selected to participate in the field test, the participating school will field test the student. You are able to monitor the student's testing progress to make sure that they finish the assessment, since the onus is always on the home school.

## Dynamic Learning Maps Alternate Assessment (DLM-AA)

# Spring Window



- The Spring 2026 window for administering the DLM-AA is March 11-May 6, 2026
- Testing hours are 7AM-4PM
- All students are required to test
  - Parents / guardians may not opt their student out of testing.

# Administering the DLM-AA – Where?

- Students must test in person, at school.
- Homebound students - apply an [RNVTA 02](#) to student's correction record
- Medically exempt students – apply an [RNVTA 01](#) to student's correction record

To encourage the best possible assessment outcome, testing environments should be familiar to students

# Teachers: Are You Ready for Testing?

- The security agreement must be completed.
- The DLM Required Test Administrator Training must be completed.
- Students must be rostered to a teacher for each assessed subject.
- Students' First Contact Surveys must be submitted.
- Student Portal must be installed on all testing devices.



# Validate Data



- Is the student enrolled in the correct district and school?
- Is the accountability district and school correct?
- Does the student need to be enrolled in more than one district or school?
- Is the student enrolled in the correct grade?
- Is the State Student Identifier (SSID) correct?
- Is the student's name spelled correctly?
- If errors are discovered *after* the test window opens, contact [Pam Hartwig](#) for assistance.

# DLM FAQs

- Can a new teacher be added to Kite after the test window opens?
  - Yes. Contact Assessments with the teacher's name, email address and building(s)/program(s) where the teacher will administer the assessment.
- Can a student be added to Kite after the test window opens?
  - Yes. Verify the alternate assessment indicator (SIS) is updated to "yes". Contact Assessments with the student's SID to have the student added to Kite.
- We've updated the student's alternate assessment indicator to "NO". Why is the student still in Kite?
  - The student needs to be manually removed from Kite. Use reason code 18 to exit the student. The [Data Management Manual](#) has specific instructions for removing a student from Kite.
- What if an IEP meeting determines the student should no longer take the DLM after the window opens?
  - Update the student's alternate assessment indicator (SIS) to "no" and exit the student from Kite Educator Portal using reason code 18.

# DLM FAQs, cont.

- Are any additional training modules required of coordinators or administrators?
  - No modules are required for test coordinators. Training modules are optional for test coordinators. For test administrators, Illinois does not have additional training requirements beyond what is in Kite Educator Portal.
- Is the Parent Portal available in Illinois?
  - Yes. Please contact Assessments for further details.
- Is language translation allowed?
  - Language translation is allowed for math and science. The teacher will need to designate this support in the PNP Profile.
- Are Test Administrators required to retain students' written products?
  - Once the teacher uploads the student's written product, the writing sample should be destroyed.

# Who Must Test?

- Unless they are rostered to take DLM-AA instead, students in grade 11 and [grade 12 as required](#) will participate in the ACT with Writing.
- Unless they are rostered to take DLM-AA instead, students in grades 9 and 10 will participate in the PreACT 9 Secure and the PreACT Secure, respectively.
- Students repeating grade 11 who have tested previously must test for accountability but have met the separate but related diploma requirement.
- Students who are completely or partially homeschooled **do not participate unless** they are receiving instruction from the public school in a tested content area.
  - ❖ *Note: These students will be included on the Pre-ID file and loaded into ACT Now. Apply [RNVTA 16](#) during the correction window for those not required to test. For students who test, they will take the **entire test**, and staff must contact ISBE after scores are posted to suppress data for subjects in which they are not receiving instruction.*
- All **English learners**, including those for whom it is their first year in a U.S. school, must participate in all parts of the assessment, assigned based on their grade level in SIS.
- All **foreign exchange students** whom your school has classified as being in grade 9, 10, or 11, must participate.
