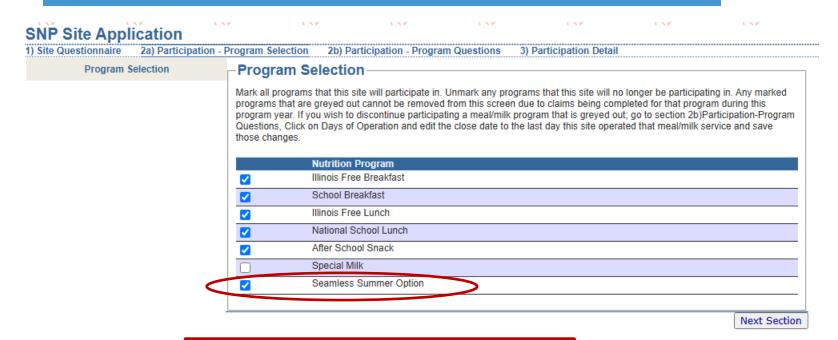

#### **Seamless Summer Option Site Application**

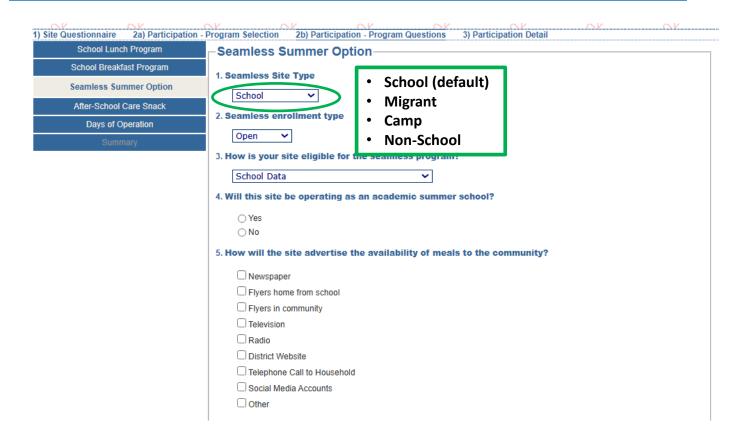
- Each site must meet eligibility requirements to apply and operate.
- One site in district must be approved to operate NSLP
- Site applications must be submitted and approved prior to operating/serving meals.
- Site applications may not be backdated to the starting date of operation if prior to application date and application approval.





- To participate in Seamless Summer Option the program must be marked under Participation-Program Selection section of the site application.
- Applications must be completed and approved prior to operating SSO sites.

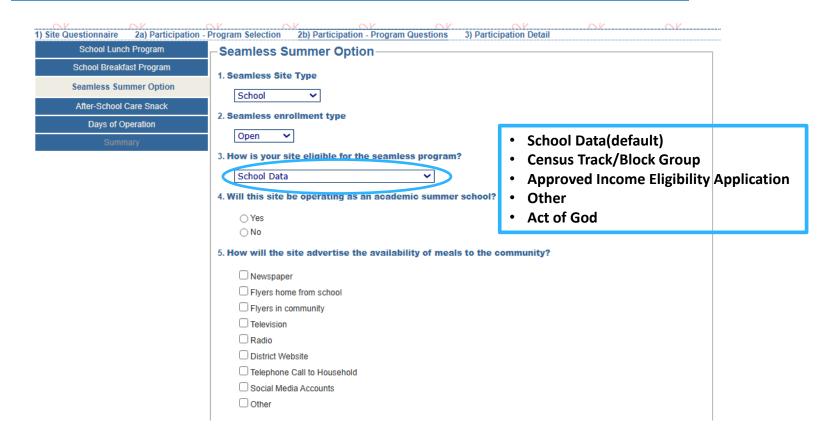



**USDA Rural Designation Map** 



Menus are required to be given to participants for each reimbursable non-congregate meal type. Menus must include the food items, portion sizes, and intended day of consumption for each meal type.









Meal service may be congregate for one meal and noncongregate for a second meal service.

Breakfast is served congregate during summer school and lunch is non-congregate and sent home with students at the end of a half day program.





Non-congregate meals may be distributed on one or multiple days in a week, Monday-Friday.


Select the serving days, Sunday-Saturday, that will be covered by all meal distribution days combined.






All non-congregate meal site applications must be approved by ISBE prior to operation and will display this error message as a reminder.
