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### Additional Updates:

**PB 100-0645**

Allows teachers in Preschool for All classrooms to hold one of the following:

1. A Gateways ECE Credential Level 5
2. An Educator License with Stipulations with a Transitional Bilingual Educator Endorsement AND have passed the ECE content test OR completed at least 9 hours of ECE coursework.

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### Additional Updates Continued:

**PB 100-0105**

Expulsion from state funded preschool programs is not allowed. Any type of transition must be accompanied by a transition plan.

Some of the data collection required includes:

1. Transitions types
2. Reason for transition
3. Mental health consultations hours



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### Additional Updates Continued:

**PA 100-0819**

Data will be used to identify chronically absent children, and to determine what support and resources are needed to encourage the habit of daily attendance.



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- Teachers observed 106,670 (81 percent) of the 132,378 children enrolled in kindergarten in FY18 on the 14 State Readiness Measures.
  - \*49 percent of children demonstrated kindergarten readiness in Social and Emotional Development.
  - \*44 percent demonstrated kindergarten readiness in Language and Literacy
  - \*30 percent of children demonstrated readiness in math. [KIDS Statewide Report](#)

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
