





To identify which incoming kindergarten students and first-semester first graders would benefit from English language services.










### **Test materials**

- Test materials were developed in color
- WIDA recommends printing materials in color if this is possible
- Materials are likely to be more engaging to students in color
- WIDA field tested these materials in both color and greyscale versions
- Student outcomes were equivalent
- Students will not be disadvantaged if they take the test with greyscale test materials

Partner with a colleague to run through a practice test administration


Identify your testing space







# Decisions made by your state


- If you can use K Screener, K MODEL, or K W-APT




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# Key Language Uses (KLUs)

Prominent Language Uses across disciplines

- Represent a systematic analysis of academic content standards & literature
- Bring focus and coherence to the language of schooling
- Prioritize and organize content and language integration






<b>Key Language Use</b> (Genre Family)	<b>Genre Examples</b> (Curriculum Contexts / Products) (adapted from de Oliveira, 2016; Derewianka & Jones, 2018)	
<b>Narrate</b> represent experiences through stories and histories, real or imagined	<ul> <li>Stories: short stories, novels</li> <li>Histories: biographies, historical accounts</li> </ul>	
<b>Inform</b> convey factual information about phenomena or topics	<b>Reports</b> : descriptive, classifying, comparative, compositional	
<b>Explain</b> give account for how or why things work	<b>Explanations:</b> sequential, causal, cyclical, systems, factorial, consequential	
<b>Argue</b> justify one's claims using evidence and reasoning	<b>Arguments:</b> book reviews, critical responses in mathematics and science

# *Goals for content-driven language instruction*



- Identify language to meet content standards
- Make visible common language patterns through a set of Language Functions (with example Language Features)

**ELD Standard:** Language for Language Arts


Language Functions: Common patterns of language use showcasing ways students might use language to meet the purposes of schooling.

Language Features: Include things like types of sentences, clauses, phrases and words, etc...




## **Proficiency Level Descriptors (PLDs)**

- Articulate multilingual learners' growth across levels of English language proficiency
- Six grade-level clusters aligned to ACCESS
- Three dimensions of language (discourse, sentence, word/phrase)
