
ACCESS 2.0 Prep Steps

- Staff Preparation




Connect to WIDA-AMS

- Materials for all windows are being shipped at the same time.



ACCESS for ELLs 2.0 Headset Specifications

The table below outlines features for headsets and recording devices and WIDA's rationale in recommending those features. Please note that WIDA does not endorse specific brands or devices.

Recommended Features	Reason for Recommendation	Alternatives not Recommended Separate headphones and microphone increase the need to ensure proper connection and setup on the computer and thus complicate the testing site set-up.	
Device: Headset	Allows for recording and playback using the same device.		
Headset Design: Over Ear Headphones	Comfortable when worn for a longer period of time by students of different ages. Weight and size of headphones can be selected based on students' age.	In ear headphones (ear buds) that are placed directly in the ear canal are more difficult to clean between uses by different students. They are	




Considerations for Audio Recording Devices:

 - Disinfecting Wipes




