<p>TEMPORARY PROVISIONAL VOCATIONAL ENDORSEMENT (CTEP) NOW AN endorsement for “Provisional Career and Technical Educator” and for the content areas and grade levels that were on the temporary provisional vocational certificate.</p> <p><u>Exchanged</u> in 2013 (no matter when issued prior to that) is valid until June 30, 2018, and may be renewed for one, five-year period provided the licensee has passed a test of basic skills and has completed a minimum of 20 semester hours of coursework from a regionally accredited institution.</p>	<p>Valid until June 30 immediately following 5 years after the endorsement was issued.</p> <p>Will be renewed only once if the licensee has</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • passed a test of basic skills, and • completed a minimum of 20 semester hours of coursework. 	<p>11 – 12</p>	<p>Field Endorsed to teach</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Agriculture education • Business, marketing & computer • Family & consumer sciences • Health careers • Technology education
<p>PROVISIONAL VOCATIONAL ENDORSEMENT (CTE) NOW an endorsement for “Career and Technical Educator” and for the content areas and grade levels on the provisional vocational certificate.</p> <p><u>Issued</u> before June 30, 2013 holder is exempt from the test of basic skills due to “once qualified, always qualified”.</p> <p><u>Issued</u> between July 1, 2013 and December 31, 2014 valid for 5 years and holder took the basic skills test for issuance, so has satisfied the testing requirement.</p> <p>Individuals applying for a CTE on an ELS starting January 1, 2015, will have to take the test of basic skills to renew. These new licenses are subject to the law, effective January 1, 2015. They will have five years to prepare for passage of the test but will be unable to renew if they do not pass.</p>	<p>Complete the renewal requirements:</p> <p>120 PD Hours or 60 PD Hours for any holder of a NBPTS master teacher designation.</p> <p>Coursework counts if it leads to a PEL or, for individuals holding a PEL, an endorsement on that license for the skill area of instruction or relates to the field of an individual’s current teaching assignment or any other field of teaching assignment.</p>	<p>7 – 12</p>	<p>Field Endorsed</p>
<p>Part-Time Provisional Vocational Endorsement (CTEPT)</p> <p>Endorsed for part-time provisional career and technical educator is valid <i>until June 30 immediately following five years after the endorsement was issued</i>.</p>	<p>May be renewed one time only upon application and payment of the fee required to register the license.</p> <p>Effective May 6, 2014</p>	<p>6 – 12</p>	<p>May teach in area of field endorsement no more than 2 periods per day.</p>
