On the following pages are selected results collected from school districts with Gifted programs. In some cases, comparisons are made with total state information.

832 Districts (and Joint Agreements) provided information about their Gifted program

164,929 Students received Gifted services (7.9\% of all Illinois students)

708 Districts (of 819, or $\mathbf{8 5 . 1 \%}$ ) offer an elementary program
659 Districts (78.9\%) offer a middle school program
400 Districts (48.1\%) offer a high school program
164,929 Students were identified and served as Gifted
2,084,187 Total students in the state ( $7.9 \%$ of all IL students served as Gifted)
98,860 Students were identified for General Intellectual Ability
66,069 Students were identified for a Specific Aptitude or Talent
4,369 Professional staff have completed three semester or four quarter hours of college credit in Gifted education

6,632 Professional staff have completed the approved Institute training
4,773 Professional staff have documented teaching experience to qualify for Gifted Education Program reimbursement

3,859 Professional staff have received training related to Gifted Education through an ISC or ROE this school year
