## **Illinois Alternate Assessment**

## Sample Task Mathematics Grade 8

<ul> <li>Present the primary task to the student. Say: Here is the number four hundred sixteen. Which is another way of writing the number four hundred sixteen?</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Point to each option and say: this one or this one or this one</li> </ul>	
	4
The student receives a score of 4 for a correct response.	
If the student does not respond, repeat the primary task <u>only once</u> exactly as it appears. If the student responds correctly after the second presentation of the primary task, the student receives a score of 4.	
If the student chooses an incorrect answer or does not respond, move to Level 3.	
<ul> <li>Turn the page to provide the general prompt.</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Re-present the primary task and answer options.</li> </ul>	2
The student receives a score of 3 for a correct response.	J
If the student does not respond or responds incorrectly, move to Level 2.	
<ul> <li>Indicate the correct answer and re-present the primary task and answer options.</li> </ul>	
The student receives a score of 2 for a correct response.	2
If the student does not respond or responds incorrectly, move to Level 1.	
If the student does not respond or responds incorrectly at Level 2, the student receives a score of 1.	

Correct answer: 400 + 10 + 6

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Say: Here is the number two hundred fifty-seven. Another way to write the number two hundred fifty-seven is two hundred plus fifty plus seven.
Turn back to the primary task page and re-present the primary task and answer options.

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200 + 50 + 7
