
## **KEY TO THE CODING: CATEGORY 3 (NONPUBLIC SCHOOLS)**

Category 3 contains only nonpublic school records. Appearing in the school position of the nonpublic school record will be 4 zeros. Nonpublic schools in Illinois are identified by a unique code. This code is a combination of 11 numbers. The first 9 numbers of the code identify the nonpublic school. The next 2 digits indicate the affiliation of the nonpublic school.



- (1) Region Code: A code of 2 numbers, from 01-56 for the 38 Regional Offices of Education. Each region is made up of one or more of the 102 Illinois counties.
- (2) County Code: A code of 3 numbers, from 001-102, assigned to each of the 102 Illinois counties in alphabetical order.
- (3) **School Code**: A code of 3 numbers, which is sequential within each county.
- (4) **Type Code:** A code of 1 letter which indicates the grade range served within a school:
  - X Elementary (PreK 8)
  - Y Secondary (9 12)
  - Z Unit (PreK 12)
  - S Special Education (PreK 12)
- (5) <u>Affiliation Code</u>: A code of 2 numbers assigned to the following affiliations:

(6) School Code: A code of 4 numbers assigned to the school. Nonpublic schools are assigned a school code of 4 zeros.
