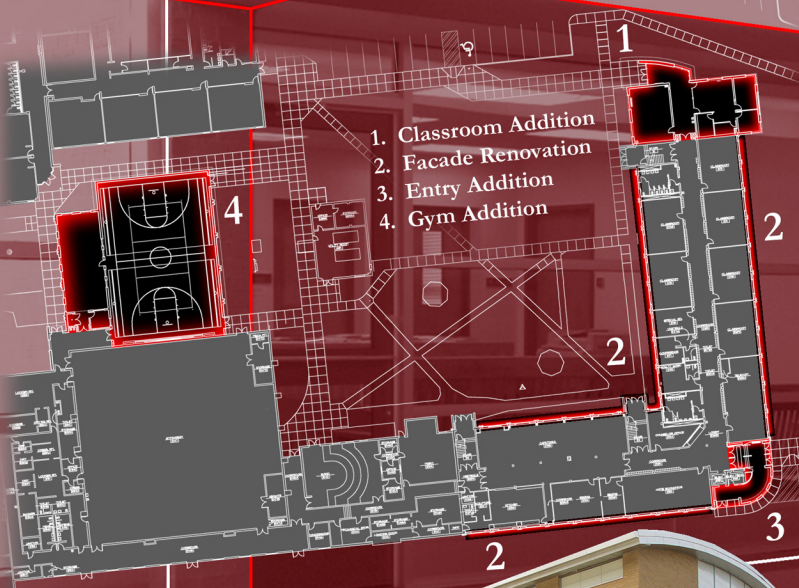

The project includes a new 8,000 s.f. gymnasium and weight room addition, a new 5,000 s.f. classroom addition, exterior facade improvements to the existing High School, and new interior finishes for portions of the existing High School.

In July of 2002, BLDD Architects, Inc. completed a feasibility study for Marshall High School. The study provided the Marshall Board of Education with a variety of approaches and associated probable construction costs from which they were able to select a desired approach.

The District was able to take advantage of the Illinois State Board of Education's Building Replacement Process to replace their old dilapidated gym and classrooms with new spaces. The District also took advantage of ISBE's Health and Life Safety process to replace deteriorated window and glass block systems on much of the existing High School exterior walls.
