SY21-22 P-EBT and Summer 2022: Uploading Data in WINS (Non-Public NSLP Eligible School)

Working in Partnership with the Illinois Department of Human Services (DHS)

What is P-EBT?

- P-EBT (Pandemic- Electronic Benefit Transfer) is a United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) food assistance benefit available to families with students who would have received free or reduced-price lunch while attending school but are not receiving these meals in school due to COVID-19 restrictions.
- Summer 2022 P-EBT issuance is \$391 per eligible student.
- SY21-22 P-EBT payment is \$7.10 per P-EBT eligible day.



P-EBT Data for Non-Public Schools

- Data for P-EBT for non-public school students will be captured in the Web-Based Illinois Nutrition System (WINS).
- Data for P-EBT includes the following for nonpublic school students:
 - Student Eligibility
 - Student Mailing Address
 - Summer 2022 P-EBT
 - P-EBT Eligible School Day



P-EBT Data for nonpublic school students

- Student Eligibility Nonpublic schools will be asked to create a file for only eligible P-EBT students.
 - For non-CEP schools in SY 21-22, this will include students eligible for free or reduced-price meals.
 - For SY21-22 CEP approved schools, as all enrolled students are P-EBT eligible, please upload all enrolled students for SY 21-22.
- Student Mailing Address Student's current mailing address, as submitted in WINS for eligible students, will be used if a P-EBT card is needed to be mailed to the student directly. Please ensure that the address provided is the current mailing address for the student.
- Summer 2022 P-EBT- There is a column titled "Enrolled in May/June". You will enter "Y" for yes and "N" for no. This will determine if the student is eligible for Summer 2022 P-EBT.



NON-CEP Approved Schools - Student Eligibility for SY21-22

- If your school was NOT CEP approved in SY21-22, then only students that met socioeconomic criteria will be potentially eligible for SY21-22 or Summer 2022 P-EBT Benefits.
- Students must be determined eligible to receive free or reduced-price lunch for the 2021-22 school year
 - if eligibility was NOT collected in SY21-22. the school must use the most recent SY eligibility for ALL enrolled students
 - (SY20-21 first, then if not available, SY19-20)
 - Using data from multiple school years is not allowed.
 - This excludes new students in eligible schools.
- The deadline to apply for SY21-22 meal benefits was July 15, 2022, per the USDA.



P-EBT Eligible Day and Covid-related Absence

- Students are P-EBT eligible on school days in which a reimbursable meal was not provided to the student to consume at school due to covid-related reason.
- COVID related absences for purpose of P-EBT eligibility for all Illinois schools will be defined as:
 - Any absence where the school directs students to stay home for a COVID-related reason. This would include a school-ordered quarantine of a student, a group of students, a classroom, or a school. It would also include any other stay-at-home order mandated by the school, whatever its duration, if it is part of the school's or the state's protocol for managing COVID outbreaks, positive tests, and/or potential exposure.
 - An absence initiated by the parent that is recognized and accepted by school officials as COVID-related. At the discretion of the school or the state, this could include a parent's decision to keep their child home after a positive test or possible exposure to COVID. It could also include, again at the discretion of the school or the state, a parent's decision to keep their child home after exposure at school in cases where the school does not direct the child to stay home.

This is why you see each month in the header row. You will enter the eligible days for each student under the corresponding month.

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
