The Prioritization of Urgency of Need for Services (PUNS) is a statewide database that records needed services for children and adults with a developmental disability who have an unmet service need anticipated in the next five years. This service, provided by the Illinois Department of Human Services (DHS), informs lawmakers of individuals needs so they can better plan for the needs of Illinois citizens with developmental disabilities.

This document was developed to assist families navigate through the various service providers that are available in the State of Illinois. It further details the services that each agency provides, the counties that they service as well as contact information.
