<b>4</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• I explain the main ideas and important information from the text.</li><li>• I connect my own ideas or experiences to the author's ideas.</li><li>• I use examples and important details to support my answer.</li><li>• I balance the author's ideas with my own ideas.</li></ul>
<b>3</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• I explain some of the main ideas and important information from the text.</li><li>• I connect some of my own ideas and experiences to the author's ideas.</li><li>• I use some examples and important details to support my answer.</li><li>• I balance only some of the author's ideas with my own ideas.</li></ul>
<b>2</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• I explain only a few ideas from the text.</li><li>• I summarize the text without including any of my own ideas or experiences.</li></ul> <p>OR</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• I explain my own ideas without explaining the text.</li><li>• I use general statements instead of specific details and examples.</li></ul>
<b>1</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• I explain little or nothing from the text.</li><li>• I use incorrect or unimportant information from the text.</li><li>• I write too little to show I understand the text.</li></ul>
<b>0</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• I write nothing.</li><li>• I do not respond to the task.</li></ul>
