## Illinois School Referenda Results—Primary Elections 2004

There were a total of 126 referenda for school districts held on March 16, 2004, for the following referendum types: bond = 29,  $\tan = 89$ , advisory = 3, and miscellaneous = 5. A summary of the results is provided in the table below.

## Please note:

- The list of the districts that follows is sorted by referendum type and school district name. The original list (without results) was extracted from the Illinois State Board of Elections website.
- Results are preliminary. They were obtained by telephone calls made by staff to school districts on March 17, 2004. Two districts, River Grove School District 85.5 in Cook County and Harrison School District 36 in McHenry County, each had their tax referenda defeated by just four votes and are exploring possibilities for appeals.
- Sixteen districts on the list had more than one referendum each.

There appeared to be five referenda that concerned district reorganization/consolidation—four out of five such referenda passed. The names of these five districts are highlighted in the file.
