## Illinois School Referenda Results-2006 General Election

There were 52 referenda introduced by 46 Illinois school districts in the November 7, 2006, general election. These school referenda are sorted into four general types: tax, bond, miscellaneous, and advisory, and each is further categorized into several more detailed categories, such as build/construct, offices/boards/commissions, school/education, boundary change, etc.

Among the 52 referenda, 28 are tax referenda and all in the category of school/education, all of the 17 bond referenda are in the category of build/construct, and the remaining seven are sorted into miscellaneous and advisory referenda: school/education (4), offices/boards/ commissions issues (2), and school boundary change–advisory (1). A summary of results, obtained on and after November 8, 2006, from participating school districts, county election departments, and the Illinois State Board of Elections, is listed in the following table.

Overall, 46 percent of the 52 referenda passed. The bond referenda fared better than the tax referenda, with a 59 percent passing rate. Voters did not approve 68 percent of the tax referenda in this election.
