ILLINOIS SCHOOL REFERENDA RESULTS—2010 GENERAL ELECTION

There were 23 referenda introduced by 21 Illinois school districts during the November 2, 2010, general election. These school referenda are sorted into three types: tax, bond, and miscellaneous.

Among the 23 referenda, 6 are tax referenda pertaining to increasing the local property tax cap for education. Eleven of the fourteen bond referenda are in the build/construct category and the remaining three bond referenda relate to issuing bonds for a working cash fund. The three miscellaneous referenda address the selection of school board members. The following table provides a summary of results obtained on November 8, 2010, from participating school districts.

Overall, 13 of the 23 referenda passed and 10 did not. Voters approved one of the six tax referenda in this election. Ten of the fourteen bond referenda passed and two of the three miscellaneous referenda passed.
