Reporting of School Assessments

<u>Public Act 99-590</u> was signed into law on July 22nd, 2016, and it requires the principal of each public school to report to ISBE, within 30 days after the beginning of each school year, information concerning the administration of assessments to students. Schools are also required to make this information public on the district's website or by distributing it in paper form. The data must be reported by October 18th, 2016. ISBE is creating a survey tool so school staff can submit the required information to the General Assembly.

ACCESS Writing Field Test

WIDA is seeking EL students to participate in a field test of the ACCESS 2.0 Writing Assessment. It's for students in grades 1-12 at all proficiency levels. For grades 1-3, it is handwritten. For grades 4-12, it is keyboarded. Sessions are a maximum of 30 minutes long. It may be administered either before or after the 2017 ACCESS administration.

Field Test Windows

- Grades 1-3 November 11th, 2016 to late January, 2017.
- Grades 4-12 November 28th, 2016 to late January, 2017.
