The Multilingual Department recognizes the quickly-changing nature of the current situation regarding COVID-19. Per the guidance we have received from Governor Pritzker and ISBE, we will be cancelling all face-to-face meetings, conferences, and professional learning effective immediately through June 30. ## State Seal of Biliteracy

After a thorough review of data and with the recommendation from stakeholders, ISBE is advising districts may recognize a SAT cut score of 480 to demonstrate English proficiency for the State Seal of Biliteracy. This change is effective immediately. This recommendation is aligned with the College Board's recommended "College and Career Ready" cut score of 480. Please note that the previous cut score, 540, will still be used by ISBE for district accountability purposes under Every Student Succeeds Act. ## **NEW!** Reminder: Non-Secure Materials


WIDA and DRC would like to remind districts that the following materials **should not** be returned to DRC at the end of ACCESS for ELLs testing:

- Test Administrator Manuals
- District and School Test Coordinator Manuals
- Grades 4-12 Online Test Administrator Scripts

These materials are not considered secure and can be recycled locally at the testing site or at a location determined by the district. Disposing of these materials locally decreases shipping costs and allows DRC to more quickly process secure test materials.
