FY 2021 EL - Title III Language Instruction Educational Program Application

Federal Title III grants – The Multilingual Department is pleased to announce that the **FY21 Title III Language Instruction Educational Program** is now available for completion on IWAS. Please note that the title of the application changed from ELL-TBE/TPI and Title III to EL-Title III Language Instruction Educational Program. Because this is a new application, program directors may have to sign up for authorization to enter and save information on the application.

To create a new application, districts need to select the EL-Title III Language Instruction Educational Program and check, "Yes" on the question, "Would you like to create new project for the current year?" Every district with an approved FY21 Intent to Apply should have their FY21 Title III LIEP applications ready for creation on IWAS.

This application does not include the Immigrant Education Program. A separate Title III Immigrant Education Program application will be released in November of 2020 when the districts eligible for the program are determined based on 2020-21 school year data. For information, click here.

NEW! Electronic results from the administration of the 2020 ACCESS for ELL's are now available on WIDA AMS. Districts may view their district results and print out individual student reports (ISR) from the site. The hard copy paper results will be delayed in their release. Due to the uncertainty of district or school staff being available to sign for the paper ISRs upon delivery later this July, DRC will have the reports delivered on August 17, 2020.

NEW! Demographic corrections for ACCESS can be made in SIS now through August 14th, 2020. This is done in SIS>Assessment Corrections>ACCESS. Assessment data corrections **do not** change a student's ongoing demographic data in their SIS record.
