NEW - Screener Update for 2017-18

The W-APT screening tool is being phased out. It will not be available for use after 2016-17. Illinois will continue to use the WIDA MODEL for K, but not for higher grade levels due to misalignment with the WIDA' new standard setting. The new English language screening tool for grades 1-12, in Illinois, will be the WIDA Screener. It's a newly developed placement test aligned to the WIDA's standard setting. There are both online and paper formats. The online version will function similarly to the online version of ACCESS 2.0, using the WIDA AMS website and DRC software components. However, the online system will only score the listening and reading domains. Writing and speaking will be scored by local district staff. The online WIDA Screener will be available at no cost to WIDA member districts. The paper version is available for purchase in the WIDA Store.

Proficiency Level Changes in 2017 ACCESS for ELLs

The <u>Illinois English proficiency criteria</u> for ACCESS testing (5.0 overall and 4.2 in reading and writing) were implemented in SY 2013-14 and remain unchanged for SY 2016-17.

However, WIDA recently re-examined the ACCESS performance standards and made changes. This is the result of a process called Standard Setting. Please refer to the announcement about the WIDA's standard setting posted below. WIDA held webinars on March 10th and 14th to explain these changes, and suggested ways to communicate its impact to students, families, administrators, and other educators.
