Thank you for accepting this Chicago Tribune Freedom of Information Act request. The Tribune seeks all records in ISBE possession regarding:

-communication of any kind, including but not limited to written or electronic records, received by or sent to Oak Park River Forest School District 200 and/or Oak Park River Forest High School from August 27, 2016 to present. To narrow our request, we are seeking information specifically related to a complaint of alleged student misconduct that occurred off-campus inside the home of a district employee.

-If not included in the above, any license information on a District 200 wrestling coach named Michael J. Powell, ID 1076114, including of a disciplinary nature, from Jan. 1, 2013 to present.

Please note the law allows withholding of disciplinary reports only if they are more than four years old, and please note the Illinois attorney general's office and numerous court decisions that have determined that exemptions 7(1)n and 7.5(q) do not apply to records of completed internal investigations.
