This letter is in response to your request for information under the Illinois Freedom of Information Act. Your request was received on Dec. 27, 2016.

On Jan. 4, our agency requested an extension until Jan. 11, 2017. On Jan. 11, our agency requested an additional extension until Jan. 18, 2017.

You have requested the following:

Request 1: all documents (including emails, memoranda and documents in electronic format) related in any manner whatsoever to House Bill 4558 (98th General Assembly), House Bills 810 and 811 (99th General Assembly) and Senate Bill 1393 - House Amendment 1 (99th General Assembly).

Request 2: all documents (including emails, memoranda and documents in electronic format) related to Representative Scott Drury's 2014 Freedom of Information Act request regarding House Bill 4558.

If you feel you have been denied your access to public records, you may file an appeal with the Office of the Attorney General's Public Access Counselor at 500 S. Second St., Springfield, IL 62706 or publicaccess@atg.state.il.us. If you choose to submit a request for review, you must do so within 60 days after the date of this response letter. The request for review must be in writing, signed by you and include (i) a copy of your FOIA request and (ii) this office's response. In addition, you have the right to seek judicial review of this response.
