**1. CALL TO ORDER / ROLL CALL**

Dora King, Chairman, called the meeting to order at 3:39 p.m. Members present: Ms. Dora King, Mr. Jerry Hieb, Ms. Evelyn Alexander, and Navy Representative Master Chief Walter Evans.

**2. Executive Session (In accordance with 5 ILCS 120/2( c)(9))**

A motion to convene executive session was called for at 2:03 p.m. Mr. Hieb motioned and it was seconded by Ms. Alexander. Motion carried 3-0.

**Call to Resume Open Session**

A motion to reconvene open session was called for at 3:39 p.m. Mr. Hieb motioned and Ms. Alexander seconded the motion. The motion carried 3-0.

**3. New Business Discussion / Action**

**a. Action – Approval of Student Disciplinary Action – Student 12-10**

The Board read the resolution: Student 12-10 will be expelled until the first day of school 2014-2015, but the expulsion will be held in abeyance as long as the student attends the Regional Office of Education Alternate program. If the student is in good standing in behavior, attendance and maintains a 2.0 GPA without any D or F term grades; he may petition the Board, in writing, for early re-entry to the district on the first day of school for the 2013-2014 school year. If these conditions are not met, the expulsion will be upheld until the first day of school for the 2014-2015 school year. A motion was called for to approve the student disciplinary action for Student 12-10. Ms. Hieb motioned and Ms. Alexander seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

Ms. King asked that the meeting be adjourned at 3:51. Voice vote, motion carried.
