Comprehensive State Plan Subcommittee Meeting

Notes from the meeting:

Susy moved to call the meeting to order.

Carolina-Seconds the movement.

- No old business to discuss.
- New business-appoint a vice chair but since we don't have a quorum we can't appoint a vice chair today. We will have to at the next meeting.
- ISAC and this subcommittee are charged with going through comprehensive plan and making a recommendation.
- Sue Taylor reported about the comprehensive plan process.
- Committee discussed the comprehensive plan and looked to see if Jersey School District included the requirements.
- What we should consider: Did they include the items in the check list and are they sufficient?
- Jersey District should have followed the format of the checklist. Any district that wants to do the comprehensive plan Sue shares the list with them.
- Any questions about Jersey's plan that we have or we would like Sue to follow up?
- Diana had a few questions on her form and Sue asked her to share with us things she saw as she was going through her notes.

Areas where Diana had some questions:

- Section 3-financial resources:
 - She felt that Jersey was transparent in their reporting but they didn't offer any kind of analysis. She wanted to know: What does all this information tell you and how does it affect what you are planning moving forward?
 - She wondered: Did Jersey include any information on the impact of withdrawal or on the impact of services?
- The articles of agreement:

- Sue stated-Because this is a standalone, we should have had a copy of their former articles of agree so we know what they were with the co-op. It will be different since they will be their own co-op.
 - Sue will share the articles of agreement with us.
- Regarding confidentiality:
 - Diana felt a lot was inferred by reference to existing procedures. What are those procedures?
- Regarding #9:
 - Diana didn't see this pulled out or articulated in any of the documents.
- Regarding 226.700 (the 3rd one down)-The continuum:
 - Diana felt it was a lot by inference-it wasn't clearly laid out. It should be more cohesively written what their continuum is.
- Diana was impressed with everything Jersey put together. Great job!
- Sue stated that regarding items related to finances or the delivery of services.
 - This districted is doing everything on their own now-even though they are a part of a co-op.
 - There isn't going to be much of a change in the services.
 - They have a good relationship with the cooperative, but they just aren't utilizing it the way it was set up to be used.
- Susy lost connection to the meeting.
- Sue will work on getting some additional information that was requested throughout this meeting (she was taking notes).
 - Items will be saved in the shared teams folder.
- We hope to have a quorum at the next meeting in order to make a decision.
- Discussed that we as new council members don't know how to adjure or what to say at times. A training on this process would be helpful. Sue and Carolina were going to speak with Barb Hobrock about this.
