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Changes for 2019

7

- Students are tied to home school
- IEP is now CWD
 - Includes students with IEPs and 504s on December 1 or between 12/1 and end of the test window
- Science proficiency is included
- Climate Survey participation is included
- No “full credit indicators”
 - Kept weights of chronic absenteeism and climate survey at the K-8 level
 - At high school, redistributed the weight of college and career readiness
- New reports available mid September



What is a Summative Designation?

- Multiple measures index of academic achievement and student success
- Developed in deep collaboration with stakeholders throughout the state
- Designed to **identify schools for supports and improvement**
 - Including schools with student groups needing support in otherwise high performing schools

What are the Designations?

9

Exemplary	Schools performing in the top 10 percent of schools statewide, with no underperforming student groups .
Commendable	A school that has no underperforming student groups , a graduation rate greater than 67 percent, and whose performance is not in the top 10 percent of schools statewide.
Underperforming	A school in which one or more student groups is performing at or below the level of the “all students” group in the lowest performing 5 percent of schools.
Lowest Performing	A school that is in the lowest-performing 5 percent of Title I eligible schools in Illinois and any high school with a graduation rate of 67 percent or less .

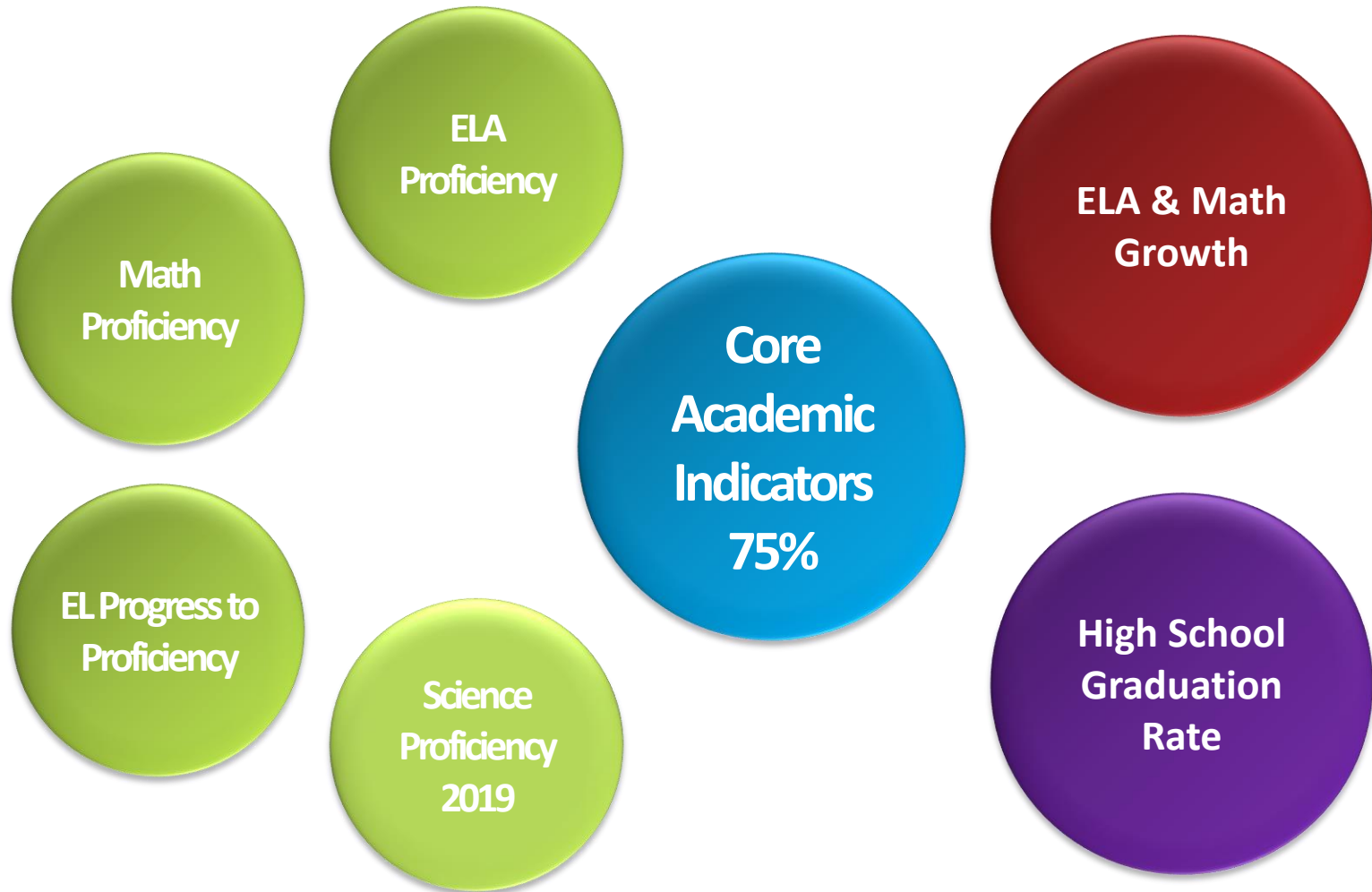

- Exemplary schools had “all students” index scores at or above 80.94 (ES) or 87.81 (HS)
- Lowest Performing schools had “all students” index scores at or below 36.9 (ES) or 17.16 (HS)
- Underperforming schools had one or more student groups whose index score was below 36.9 (ES) or 17.16 (HS)
- Commendable schools had scores ranging from 80.93 – 36.99 (ES) or 87.78 – 18.41 (HS) but with no students groups whose index scores were at or below 36.9 (ES) or 17.16 (HS)

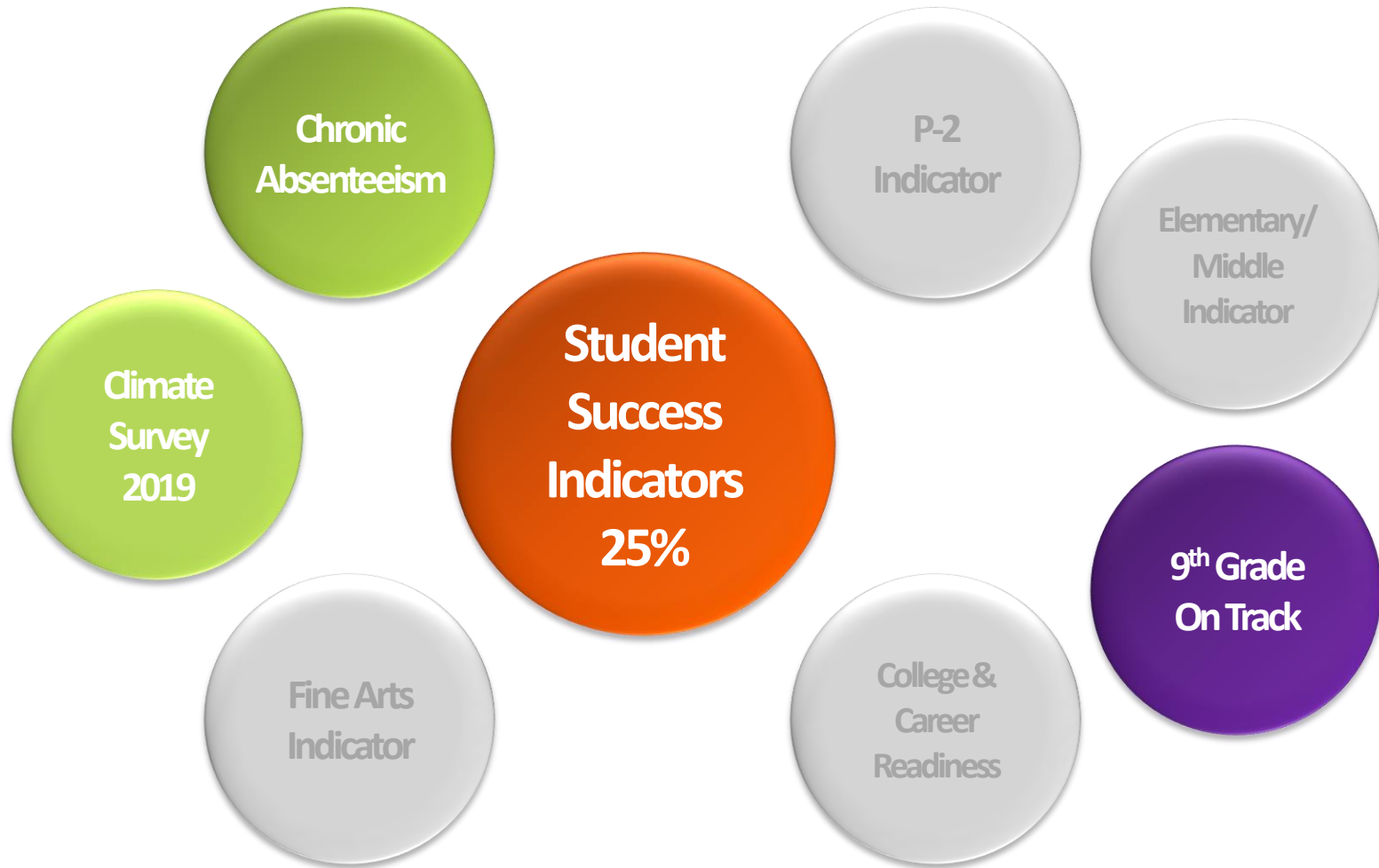

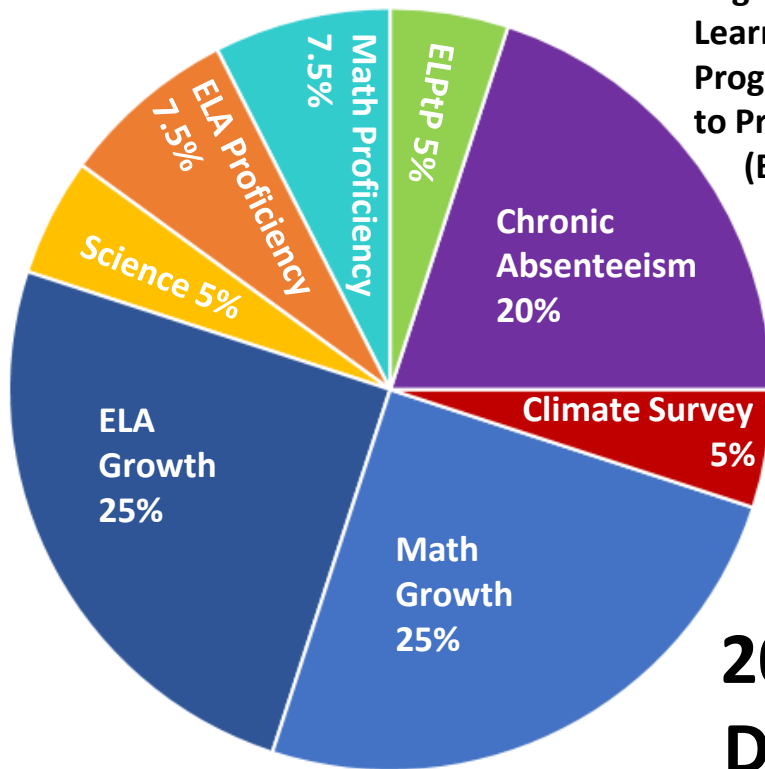

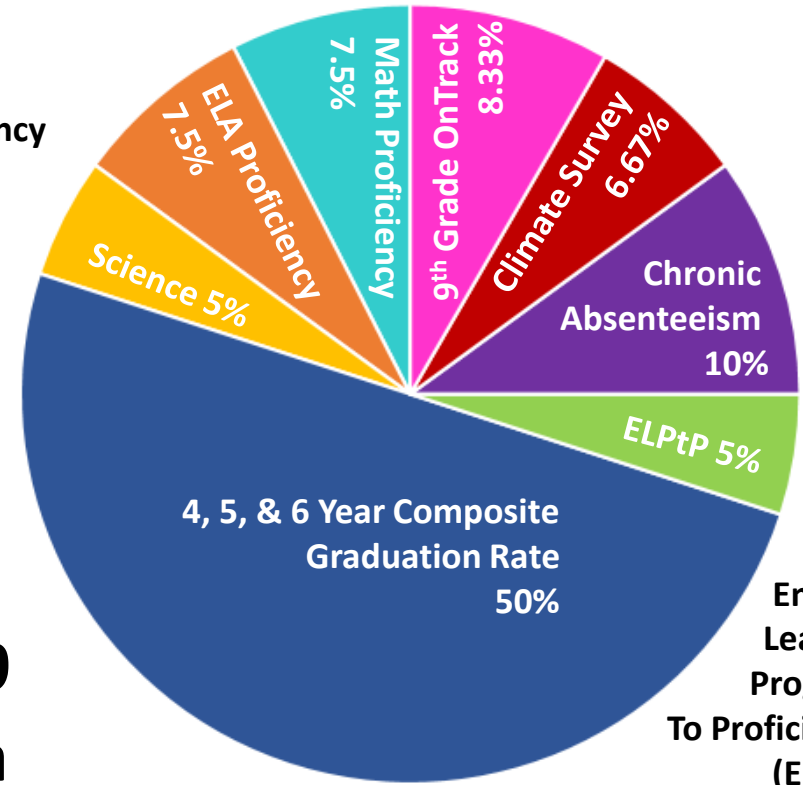

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What happens to missing indicators?

14

- If a school is missing an indicator (e.g. ELPtP or climate survey), the weight of the missing indicator is distributed **proportionally** to the other indicators in the category.

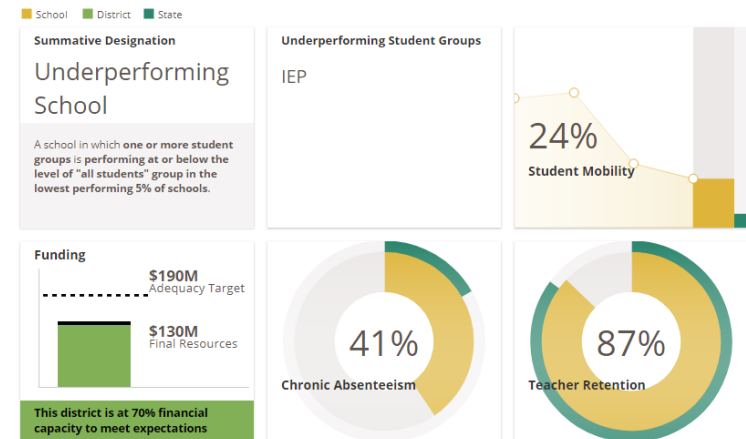

School Snapshot



Who Counts?

- Students who have been at the school for “at least half the school year”
 - Operationalized as 134 calendar days
 - Why 134 calendar days?
 - Average length of every school calendar in the state divided in half
- Groups with at least 20 students per indicator in at least 5 of 8 indicators, of which 1 must be a student success school quality indicator



Counts Where?

- Students are assigned to their home school of longest enrollment, where that enrollment is greater than or equal to 134 calendar days.
 - Except for Graduation Rate, where the “Last Enrollment” rule applies.
- Home school is a change from 2018, which was serving school (except when it wasn’t, which was often for outplaced students).



Where did you get my data?

19

- Schools without measured grades we “back map”
 - Find individual IDs of students who attended the school in prior years and move forward in time to the first available data point.
 - Priority is on most current data, most current enrollments

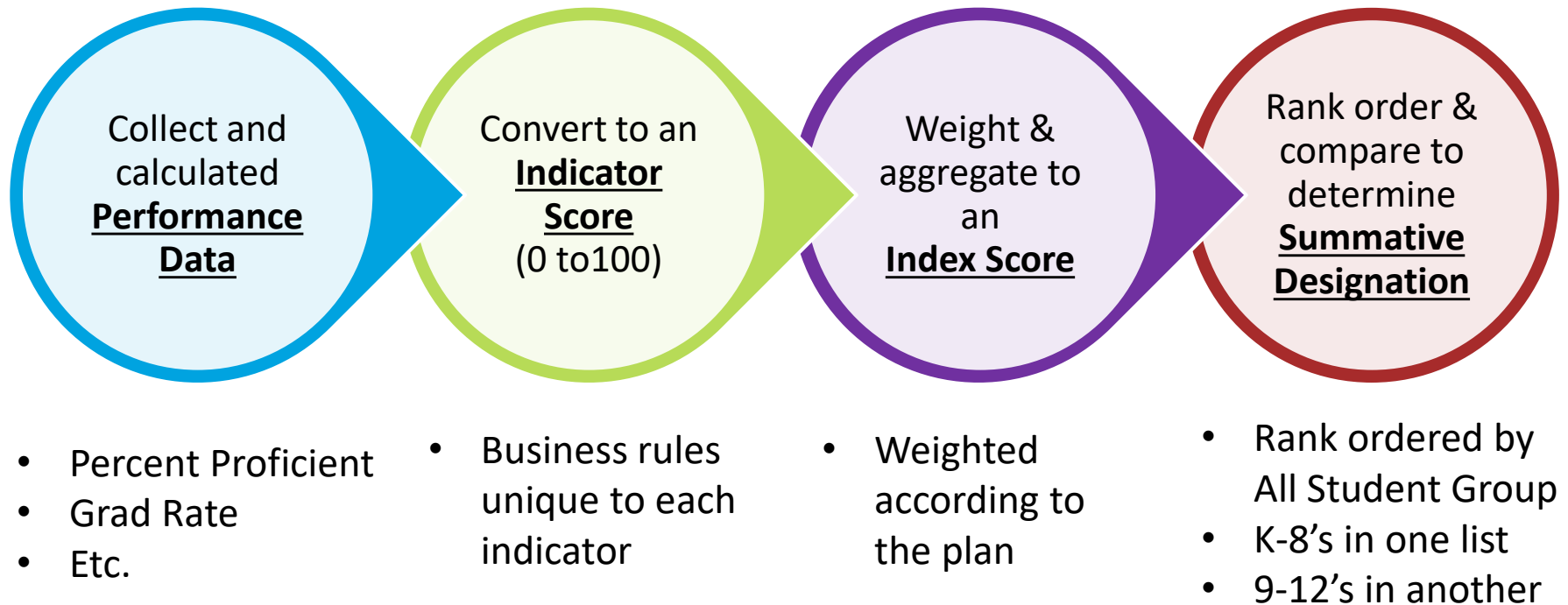

Process In Action - FAQ

27

- Do you draw the lines for the top 10% and lowest 5% at the same time?
 - Yes. Only after drawing those lines do we compare.
- If a school in the top 10% has an underperforming student group, do they drop down to commendable, or to underperforming?
 - Underperforming. The underperforming designation overwrites the exemplary designation.
- Will I get a new summative designation every year?
 - Yes. How that will impact supports has yet to be determined.

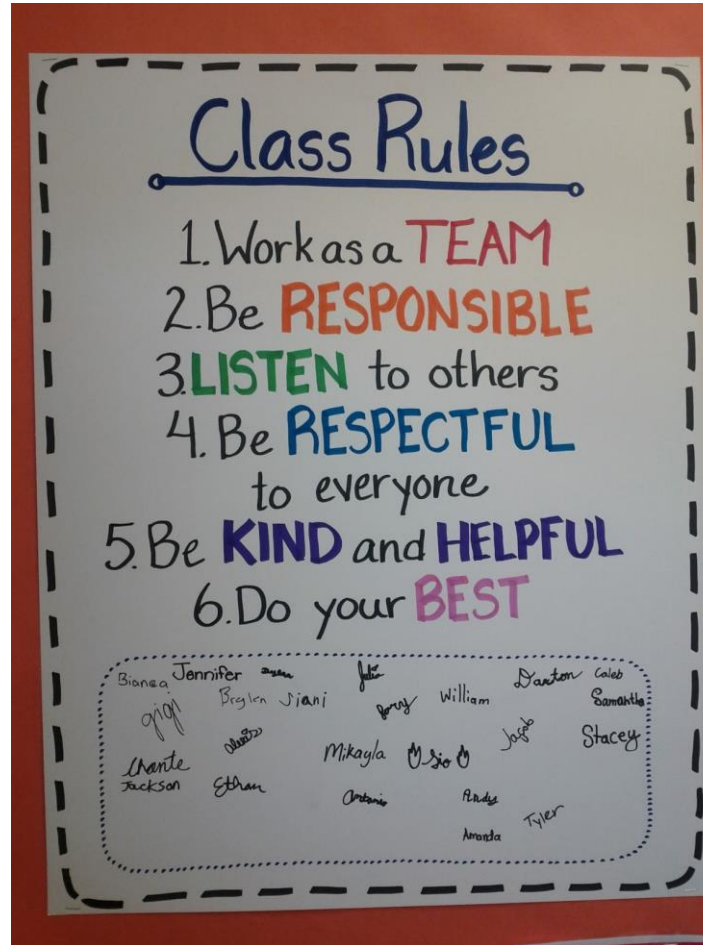

- **Percent Proficient ÷ Interim Target**
 - If Percent Proficient ÷ Interim Target $\geq 1 \Rightarrow$ 100 points
 - If Percent Proficient ÷ Interim Target $< 1 \Rightarrow$ Ratio * 100 points
- **Percent Proficient = Students proficient on all tests ÷ Students Tested (or 95% of those who should have)**
 - K-8: Levels 4 & 5 on PARCC and 3 & 4 on DLM
 - 9-12: Levels 3 & 4 on SAT and DLM
- **Interim Targets**
 - Vary by student group and subject
 - Were smoothed out to 1 year increments

Scoring Rules- Growth

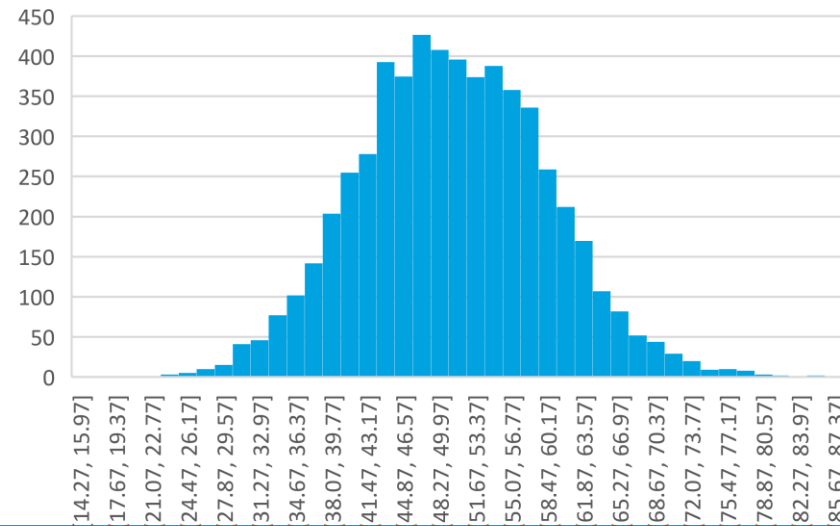
- Growth is measured by Mean Student Growth Percentile (Mean SGP)
 - Average of individual student growth percentiles (SPGs)
- Key criteria for selecting a growth measure was that different student groups have access to the full range of growth scores
 - Works because students' progress is compared to students who started out in the same place the year prior
- SGP calculation includes multiple years of data

- **ELA Growth: Average of individual SGPs**

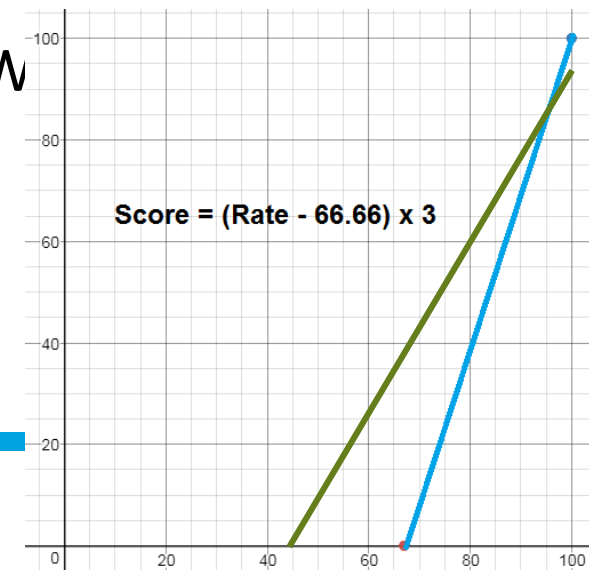

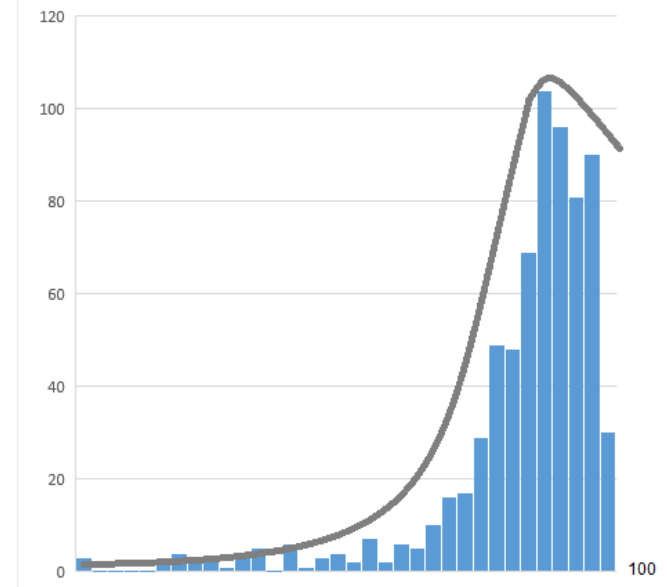

 - 95% is a data quality standard for full representation and should be the target, even if it is not yet the state norm
 - 50% is the minimum participation rate to generate reports for 5 Essentials, the survey given in 95% of schools
- **Scoring: [(Survey Participation Rate* (20/9)) – 111.11]**
 - Ceiling of 95%, floor of 50%

SUMMATIVE DESIGNATIONS

Summative designations help families and communities understand how well schools are serving all students. Illinois has four summative designations: Exemplary School, Commendable School, Underperforming School, and Lowest-Performing School. Underperforming schools and Lowest-Performing schools receive additional funding and supports to build local capacity and improve student outcomes. Multiple measures of school performance and growth determine a school's designation. The federal Every Student Succeeds Act requires states to provide every school a summative designation, beginning in 2018. ISBE will include school designations on the 2018 Illinois Report Card at www.illinoisreportcard.com.
