2. Given these results, what additional analyses might ISBE conduct to better understand the impact of the pandemic on performance (i.e., overall, by group, and instructional condition)?

The IL State leadership is evaluating options for a new summative assessment system; specifically, one that employs a through-course interim assessment design. In light of comments from the TAC and others, ISBE is clarifying its vision for this assessment system and eliciting feedback from stakeholders prior to developing and releasing a request for proposal (RFP). We will use this time to discuss what has been done thus far and what is planned for the future. The TAC will be asked to provide recommendations that inform the work moving forward.

11:10-12:15 PLANNING FOR ACCOUNTABILITY IN 2022

For the first part of this discussion, we would like to provide time for the TAC to respond to concerns and options for consideration outlined by ISBE in November, as presented in Doc_4_2022 And Beyond V5.

- Per the requirements specified in IL's 2021 waiver, data from 2021-2022 should be used to support school identification in fall of 2022. To mitigate concerns around the reliability of results due to low participation and other pandemic-related issues, ISBE is considering a third school identification status category for 2022.
- Issues related to missing data in 2021 will complicate or invalidate previously established procedures for calculating school performance on many indicators. For this reason scoring rules for some indicators may need to be revised.

Focal Questions for the TAC:

- 1. What clarifying questions do you have related to the issues and recommendations presented in Doc_4_2022 And Beyond V5?
- 2. What general recommendations do you have related to how ISBE should address concerns related to implementation of the accountability system in 2022? What values/priorities should be represented in the decisions made?

3. Generally, what information or analyses might help inform ISBE's decisions about the types of modifications that are appropriate/necessary in 2022 and beyond?

Today we will discuss three indicators that have been highlighted as potentially requiring a modification in 2022: English Learner Progress to Proficiency (ELPtP), Growth and Chronic Absenteeism. For the remainder of this session we will begin to discuss options for calculating and scoring the ELPtP school indicator in 2022.
