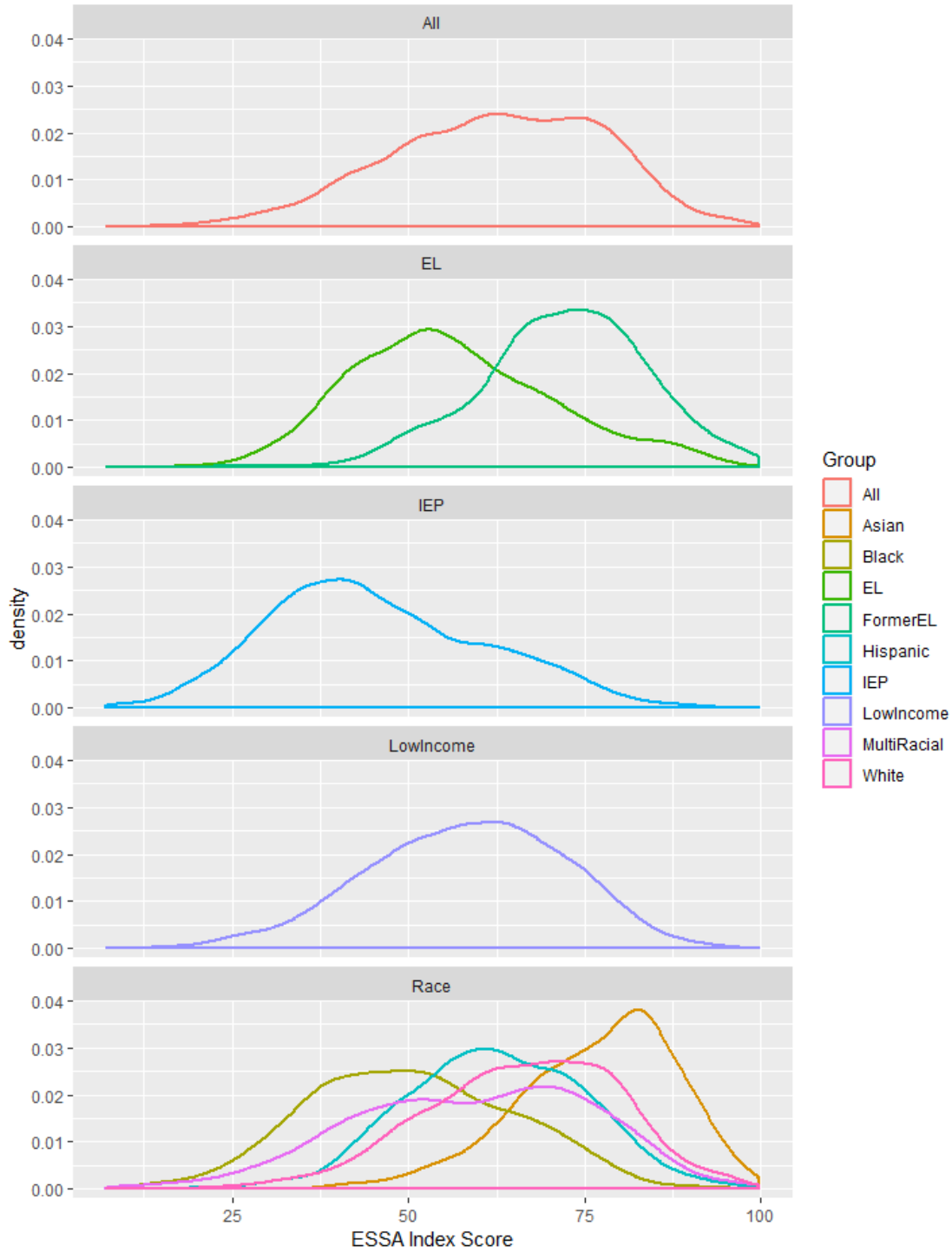

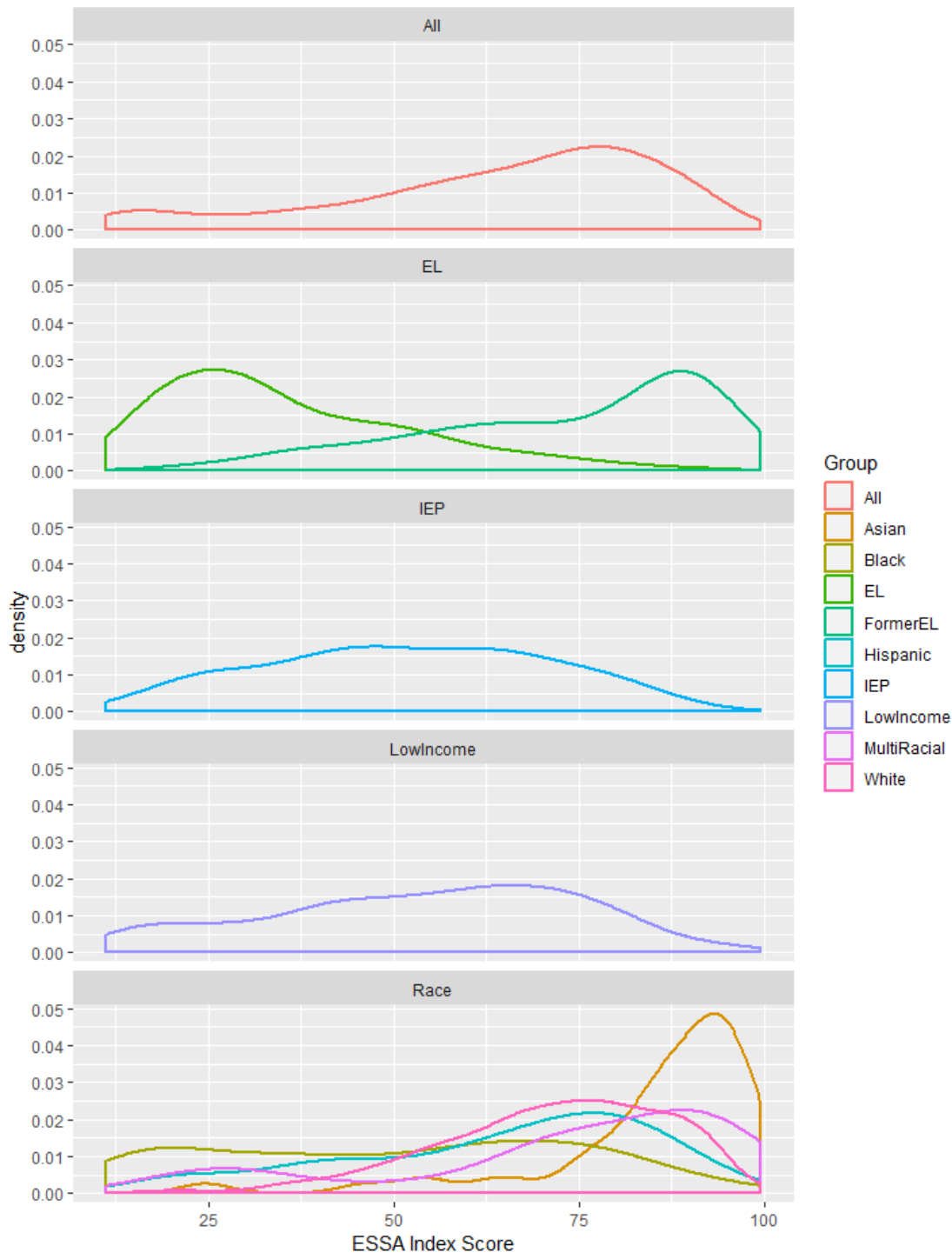

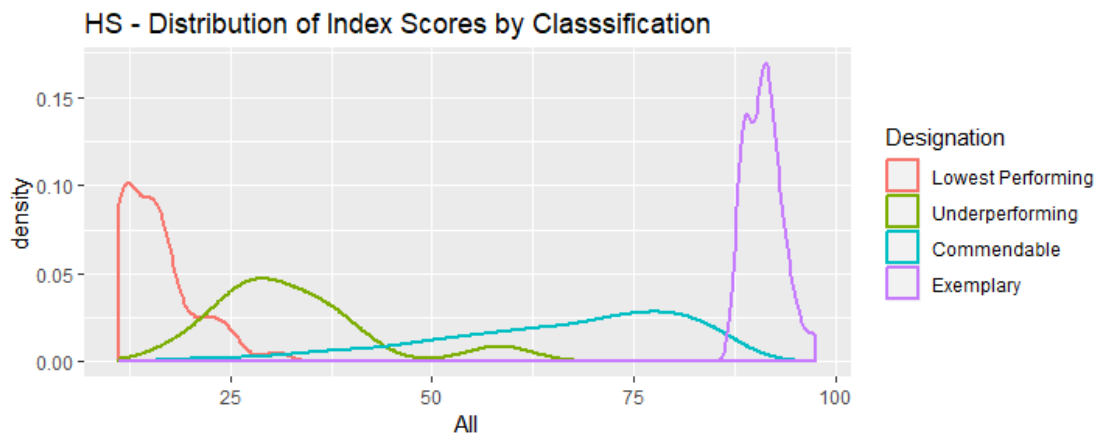
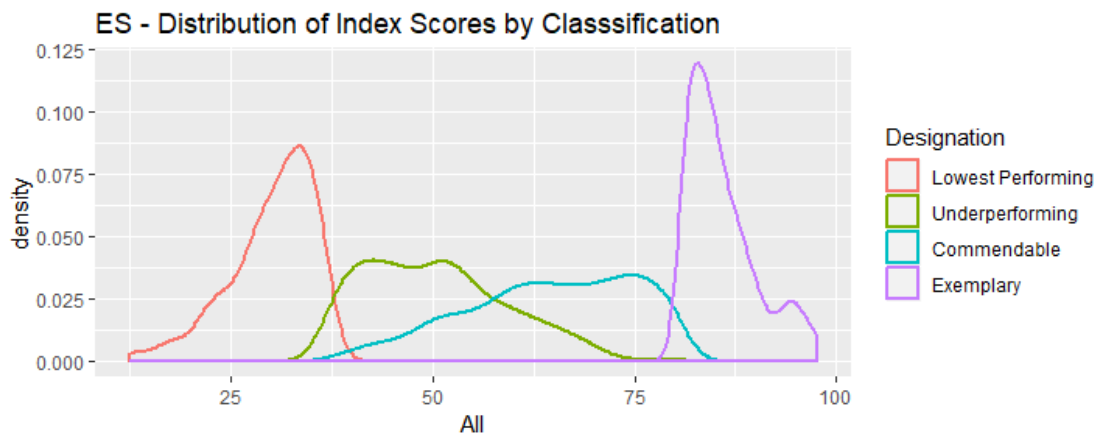

Schools Identified by just One Subgroup

As show in Table 5 above, 427 elementary schools and 10 high schools were Identified as *Underperforming* based on a single subgroup. For just this subset of schools, Tables 7 and 8 provide summary counts for by the identifying subgroups.

Additional Examination of Elementary School Identification

- In elementary school, the IEP subgroup alone triggered identification for 372 schools out of the total of 550 schools Identified as Underperforming (427 of these were triggered by a single subgroup).
- The IEP subgroup was triggered for 111 out of the 123 elementary schools identified as Underperforming based on more than one subgroup.
- Table 9 below provides “unconditional” counts by subgroup for elementary schools identified as Underperforming based on two or more subgroups.
- Table 10 provides “conditional” counts by showing the combinations of subgroups that identified elementary schools identified as Underperforming based on two or more subgroups. Only combinations that accounted for more than 5% of the identifications were included.
