# Setting the Stage

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## Goals of Discussion

- Review the distribution of the School Index Scores obtained in 2018
  - For elementary and high schools
  - For all students and each student group
  - For schools identified in each of IL's summative designation categories
- Identify notable differences that require additional analysis and discussion

## Data

- For each school available data included: grade band (e.g., elementary or high school), overall summative designation, school index scores for all students and each student group (with N>20); and the specific student group(s) leading to a school's classification of Underperforming

## Next Steps

- We will consider the performance of each indicator and its contribution to the School Index Score (overall and by student group)
- Look at the relationship between school characteristics and school performance, including summative designations

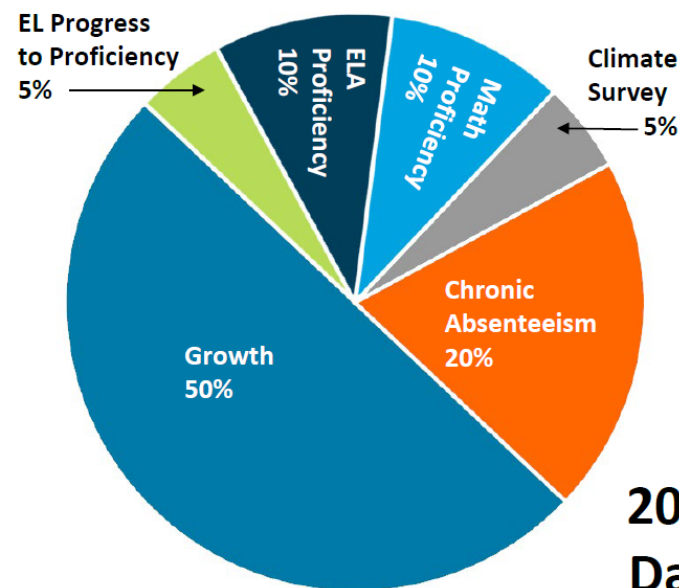
# School Index Score

- The School Index Score is the weighted sum of the individual indicator scores.
- Within each school, School Index Scores are calculated for all students and each student group having an N-count of 20 or greater.
- Schools are designated in one of four categories based on their overall and sub-group performance.

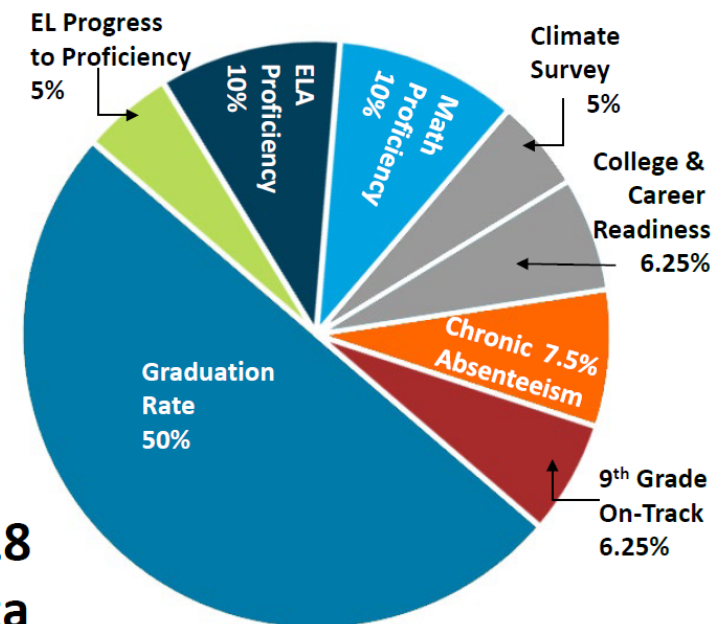

# School Summative Designations

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<p><b>Exemplary</b></p>	<p>A school that has <b>no underperforming student demographic groups</b> at or below the “all students” group of the lowest 5 percent of Title 1 schools, a graduation rate of greater than 67 percent, and whose performance is in the <b>top 10 percent</b> of schools statewide. May apply to <b>serve</b> in the IL-EMPOWER network of partners.</p>
<p><b>Commendable</b></p>	<p>A school that has <b>no underperforming student demographic groups</b> at or below the “all students” group of the lowest 5 percent of all Title 1 schools, a graduation rate greater than 67 percent, and whose performance is <b>not in the top 10 percent</b> of schools statewide. May apply to <b>serve</b> in the IL-EMPOWER network of partners.</p>
<p><b>Underperforming</b></p>	<p>A school in which <b>one or more student demographic groups is performing at or below the “all students” group</b> of the lowest 5 percent of all Title 1 schools. Schools that receive an Underperforming School designation <b>will receive Targeted Support</b>.</p>
<p><b>Lowest Performing</b></p>	<p>A school that is in the <b>lowest-performing 5 percent</b> of Title I schools in Illinois and <b>any high schools that have a graduation rate of 67 percent or less</b>. Schools that receive a Lowest Performing School designation <b>will receive Comprehensive Support</b> through IL-EMPOWER.</p>

- Exemplary schools had “all students” index scores at or above 80.94 (ES) or 87.81 (HS)
- Lowest Performing schools had “all students” index scores at or below 36.9 (ES) or 17.16 (HS)
- Underperforming schools had one or more student groups whose index score was below 36.9 (ES) or 17.16 (HS)
- Commendable schools had scores ranging from 80.93 – 36.99 (ES) or 87.78 – 18.41 (HS) but with no students groups whose index scores were at or below 36.9 (ES) or 17.16 (HS)

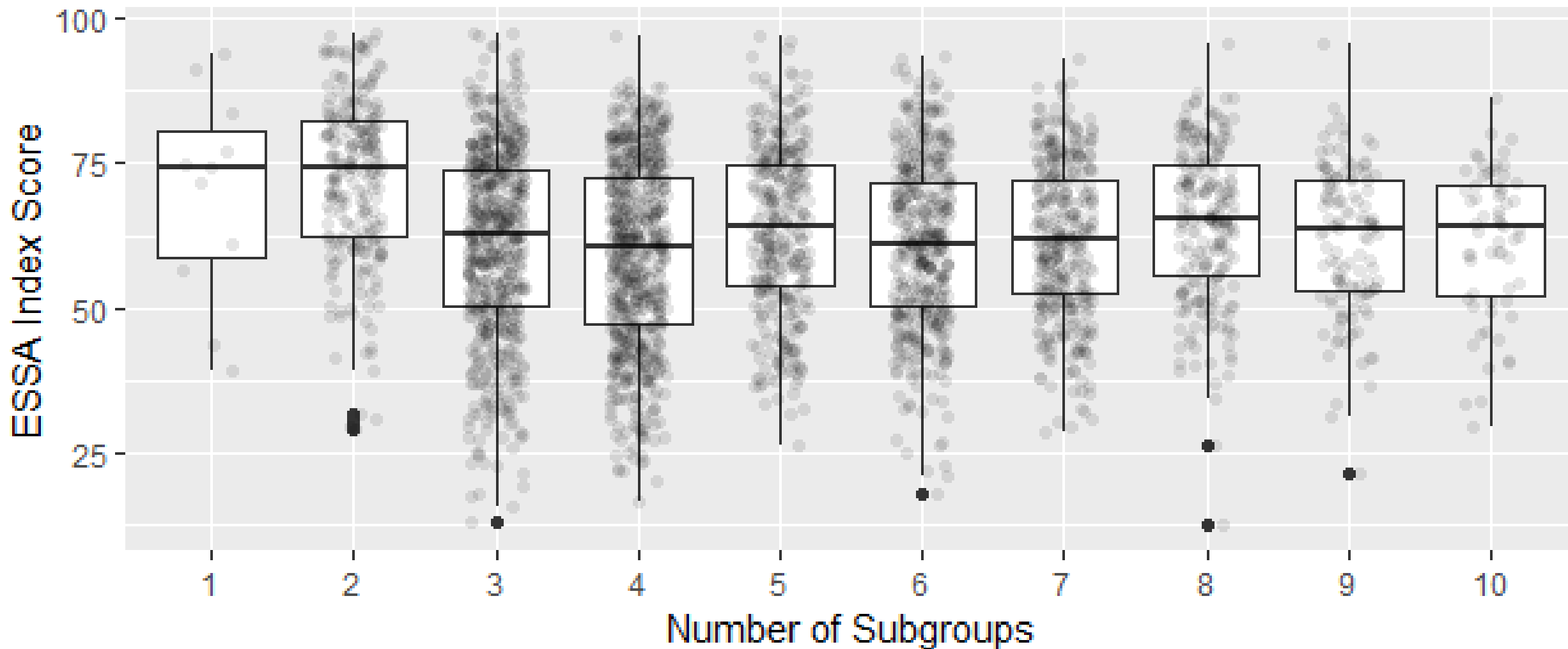

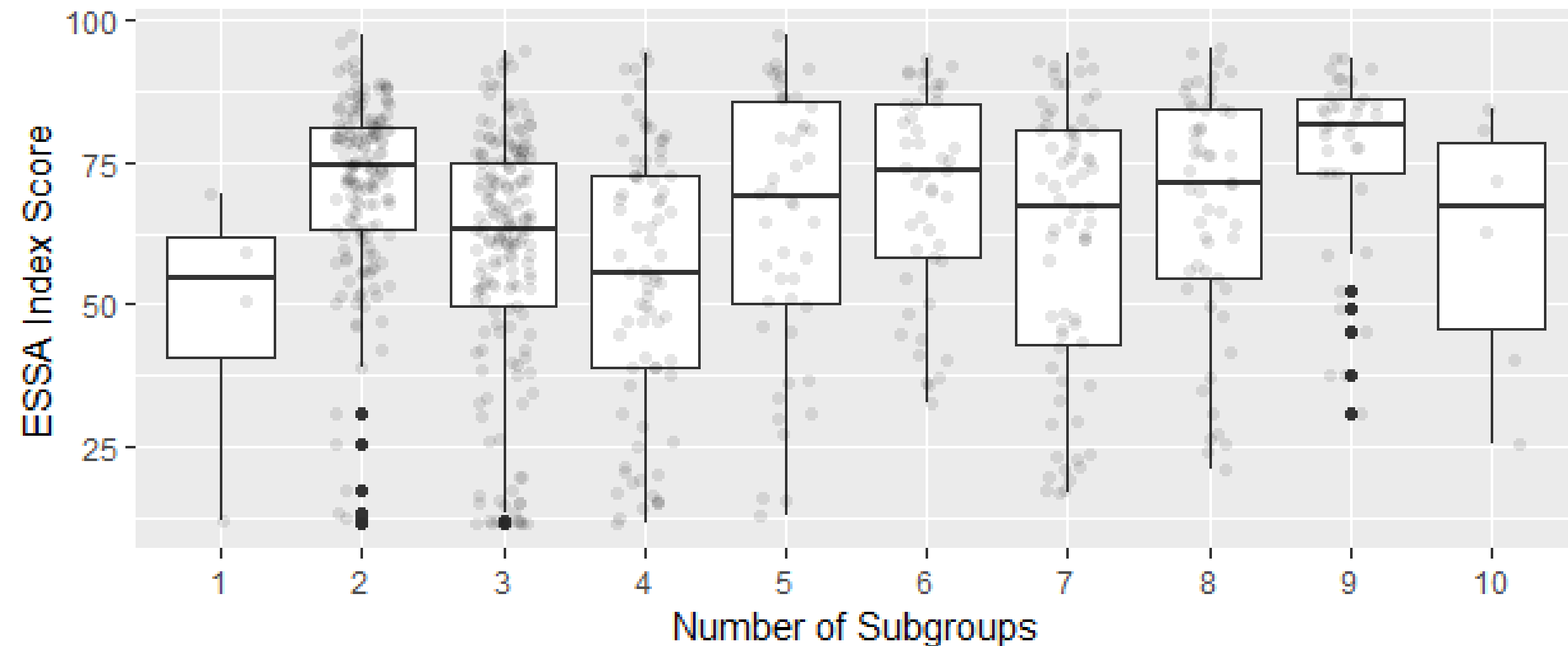
