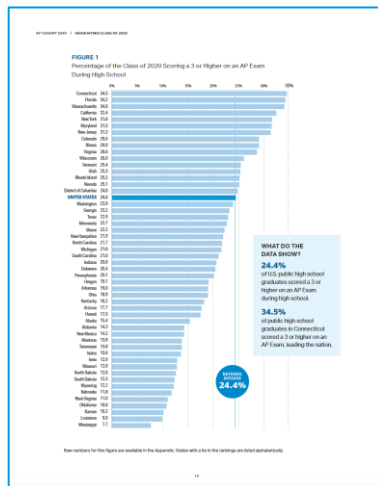


Successes from the Class of 2020

Scoring 3+

- 27.3% of the Class of 2018 Scored a 3 or Higher on an AP Exam During High School.
- 28.4% of the Class of 2019 Scored a 3 or Higher on an AP Exam During High School.
- **29.0% of the Class of 2020 Scored a 3 or Higher on an AP Exam During High School.**

Successes from the Class of 2020

Reveals the progress states have made over 1, 3, 5, and 10 years toward ensuring that their students have the opportunity and preparation to succeed in AP



Illinois had a .6 percentage-point 1-year increase in the percentage of public high school graduates scoring a 3 or higher on an AP Exam in 2020.

Illinois had a 12.5 percentage point increase over 10 years in the percentage of public high school graduates scoring a 3 or higher on an AP Exam in 2020.

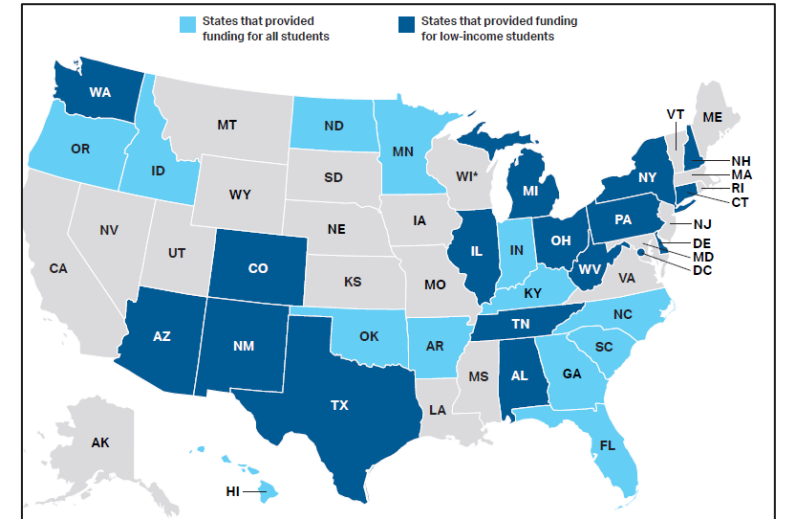
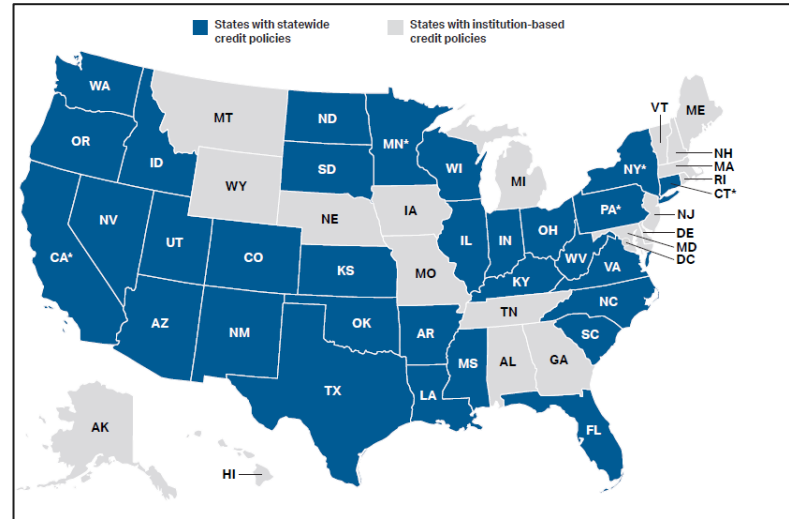
