All coursework must be completed through a regionally accredited institution with a C- grade or higher. Remedial coursework (which normally is coursework below the 100 level) cannot be used. A licensure specialist, regional superintendent, or assistant regional superintendent may complete the evaluation and upload this worksheet into the educator's ELIS account in the Images section once completed.
