FY 21 After School Programs – Non-school District Frequently Asked Questions

Question 1: What criteria is used to identify "low-income" for this grant?

Answer: To calculate the low-income count, elementary schools may use the number of students eligible for free and reduced-price meals. For middle and high schools, the free and reduced-price count generated at the school or from the elementary schools that feed into the middle and/or high schools may be used to establish the low-income count at the receiving middle or high school.

Question 2: Are there age requirements for student participants?

Answer: No, students may be of any age.

Question 3: If we have funding from the FY20 After School Program which ends June 2021, can we still apply to this round of funding as long as we are serving a different cohort of students with this funding?

Answer: Yes, funds must be kept separate and students served non-duplicate.

Question 4: Can grant funds be used to subsidize student stipends/wages, if our program has a workforce development component?

Answer: Yes, provided such stipends/wages meet the goals of the RFP.

Question 5: I know individual grant awards won't exceed \$3 million, but is there guidance on a minimum amount to apply for?

Answer: There is no dollar amount limit for a request. However, ISBE staff will determine allocations as provided for in the RFP and ensure opportunities for as many students as possible.

Question 6: Do all funds need to be spent by August 31, 2021?

Answer: Yes, the grant period will start no sooner then January 4, 2021 and go through August 31, 2021.

Question 7: Can funds be used to cover professional development related costs for program, executive, and admin staff supporting the ASP program?

Answer: Yes, as long as the criteria is met as listed in the RFP.

Question 8: Are for-profit organizations eligible if all criteria are met?

Answer: Yes, as long as the criteria is met as listed in the RFP.

Question 9: If we received funding in FY20 do we need to complete a new application for FY21?

Answer: This is a competitive grant for non-school district entities and will be reviewed and scored separately.

Question 10: Can funds be used towards organization-wide strategic planning, as all org work is linked to ASP program?

Answer: Funding for programming should be utilized for the purpose of serving students and to support the goals as listed within the RFP.
