USDA Foods deliveries begin in August.





School year 2022-23 USDA Foods on hold were released.





USDA foods may be held for up to 3 months, for free.





5 case minimum per delivery site, per month





ISBE plans to pay the following Lanter delivery fees during school year 2023-24.

Delivery	\$6.70 per case	13.5%		
Custom Delivery	\$0.75 per case	0%		
Private Storage	\$0.79 per case, per month	13.5%		



ISBE will no longer pay fees associated with refused deliveries.

Prevent refusals by holding deliveries when needed.

USDA Foods Trucks Cancelled:

 100362 refried beans – 2 of 3 trucks cancelled, but we ordered 2 more

 100212 mixed fruit, canned – 3 of 24 trucks cancelled



USDA Foods Trucks Cancelled:

 110651 orange juice cups – 10 of 10 trucks cancelled, but we ordered 8 more of 100277 orange juice cartons





USDA Foods Trucks Cancelled:

100219 peaches sliced, canned –
 2 of 7 trucks cancelled

100220 peaches diced, canned –
 7 of 22 trucks cancelled



USDA Foods Trucks Cancelled:

 100315 peas, canned – 1 of 3 trucks cancelled

 110177 spaghetti sauce – 1 of 3 trucks cancelled, but we ordered 1 more



USDA Foods Trucks Cancelled:

 110186 salsa – 1 of 2 trucks cancelled, but we ordered 1 more

 110187 tomato sauce – 1 of 1 trucks cancelled



Processed Products:

4 of 4 peach trucks to National Food Group were cancelled – prorated allocations down to 33%





Processed Products:

National Food Group garbanzo beans – we received pounds from another state, so SFAs that originally diverted pounds for SY23-24 will receive their pounds – check ProcessorLink





Unused school year 2022-23 USDA Foods diverted to processors were swept on June 30, 2023.





School year 2023-24 DOD Fresh funds are available now in FFAVORS.

USDA Foods final PAL Factor is \$0.365. ISBE's estimate was \$0.39.





USDA Foods / commodities / brown box



- Order once per year via ISBE's Illinois
 Commodity System (ICS) order updates can
 be made throughout the year
- Delivered monthly, August through April
- Anticipated USDA Foods Chart helps in planning menus and storage needs
- Schools pay the delivery cost (\$6.70/case)

Spending Option #2

DOD Fresh, fruits and vegetables

- Allocate a portion of PAL once per year
- Order weekly via FFAVORS
- Receipt weekly via FFAVORS
- Delivered weekly, August through end of school year
- \$150 minimum order per delivery
- No separate delivery cost to the school



Spending Option #2

DOD Fresh, fruits and vegetables

Receipt within 5 days of the delivery date





Spending Option #3

Diversion to Processor

- Allocate a portion of PAL once per year
- Order from your contracted distributor
- Delivered based on distributor contract terms
- Delivery cost based on distributor contract terms
- Receive value of USDA Foods



Value Pass Through Systems

- Direct discount
- Refund or rebate
- Indirect discount (net off invoice)
- Fee for service





Processor Inventory


Enforcing the sweep policy to reduce inventory at processors

- Monitoring usage throughout the year
- SY24 pounds will be swept June 30, 2024












